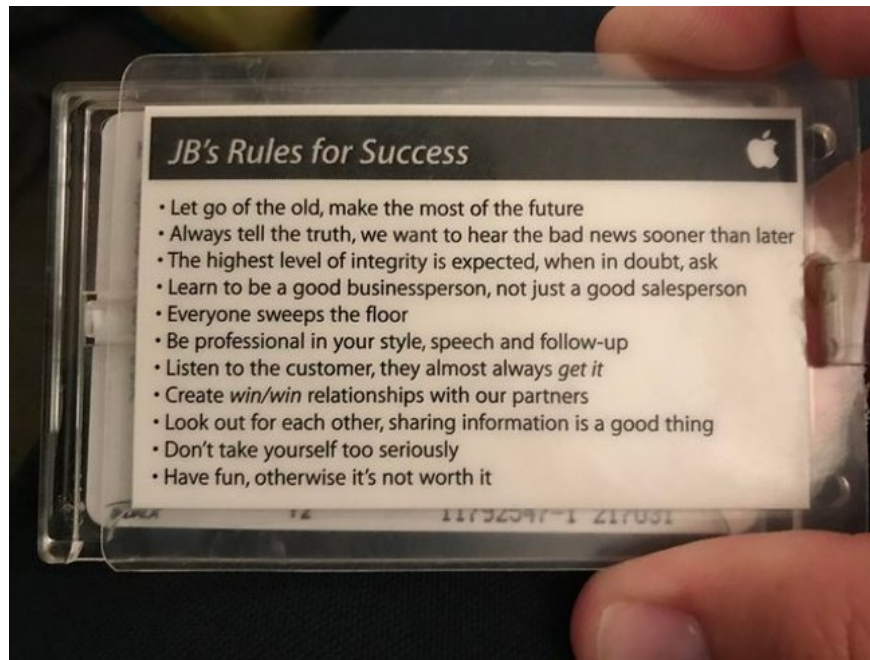

The " JB " on the above image stands for **John Brandon** , at that time the Vice President of Apple's US and Pacific Regional Business.

*" He was a great person every time I had a chance to contact, even though he had a higher position, and I was just a bad employee but that was not a barrier. John Brandon seemed to be always Following the above rules makes the whole organization feel that it is something really special, "Dunsany shared.*

In 2004, Apple is not a big technology like today. At the time, Apple had just unveiled the first iPod Mini, while Steve Jobs was still in the position of CEO and the first project that later became the **iPhone** was just launched in Cupertino, California.

**Huxley Dunsany** shares his favorite number 5 rule, *" Everyone has to clean the floor ."*

*' That means there is no' low-end 'job or not important so you don't have to help. Or to put it another way, never think that you are an extremely important person because you are working for Apple, you have just been promoted, or you have achieved a massive income every year - the basics are always It's important and you're always ready to help others no matter what your position is, where you are, 'the former employee added.*

Huxley Dunsany was a salesman in a retail store called **Apple Solutions Consultant** in 2004. However, it is clear that the success rules that Apple applied to employees at that time could apply in very Many different jobs and industries, especially in the retail and service sectors.

Below is a complete list of **11 success rules for working at Apple** :

1. Forget the old ones to make the most of what will come in the future.
2. **Always tell the truth** , we want to hear the bad news sooner rather than later.
3. The highest level of honesty is always expected, when questioning anything, ask questions.
4. Be a good businessman, instead of just a good salesperson.

5. **Everyone has to clean the floor .**
6. Keep the professionalism in style, speaking and how to follow customers.
7. Listen to customers, they almost always realize this.
8. **Create a mutually beneficial relationship with your partner .**
9. Be considerate of colleagues, sharing information is a good thing.
10. **Don't force yourself to be too serious .**
11. Be happy, otherwise this job is not worth you.
