Queries to DeepSeek will be routed back to China and censored.

The Guardian's report also points out that the open source version of DeepSeek R1 will not have censorship like the iPhone and Android apps, but not everyone will have the ability or desire to use this version.

With what happened, users need to be cautious and consider carefully before choosing to use products like DeepSeek.
