

Recover corrupted Word 2016 files

To restore Word 2016 files fully and completely, the sooner you do it, the more effective it will be, especially when you apply one of the 4 simple Word 2016 file recovery tips that Taimienphi Instructions will be given below, as soon as a corrupted file is detected.

While working with Word 2016 editing software or newer versions such as Word 2019, 2016, 2010,. sometimes the screen appears with the message: "**Word experienced an error trying to open the file. .**" then my condolences to you. This means that the Word file has been corrupted and cannot be used anymore.

However, if you apply some of the tips that Taimienphi shares below, you can still quickly retrieve part or even all of the corrupted text content.

Instructions for recovering corrupted Word 2016 files

Using the trick to restore Word files when errors occur is only a temporary solution. In the long run, you need to find out the cause of the error in the head to find a way to fix it. It's best for you to update or install the latest version of this **office utility** tool , the quick download link for Word 2016 will be shared by Taimienphi shortly.

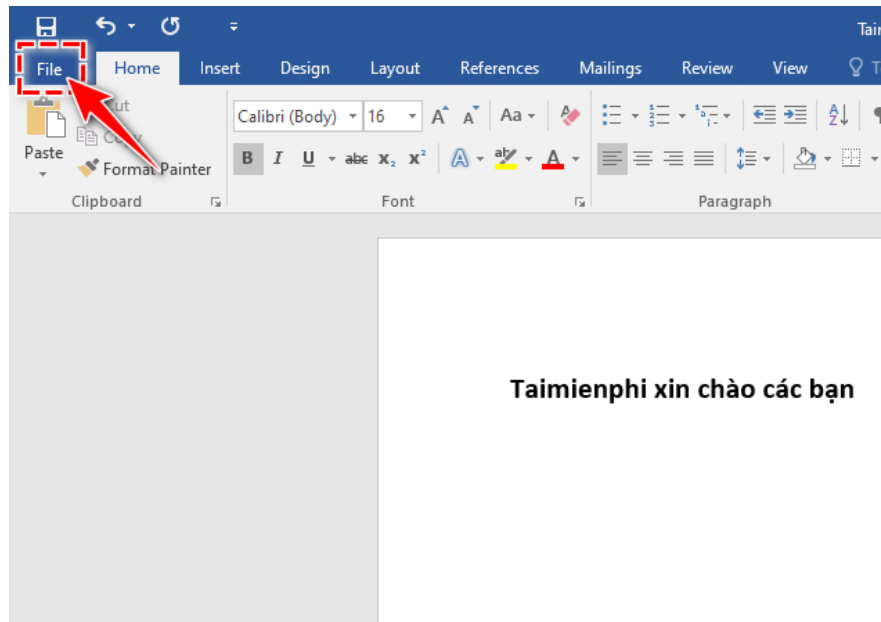

Next, choose one or do the following methods one by one to restore corrupted Word 2016 files on your computer.

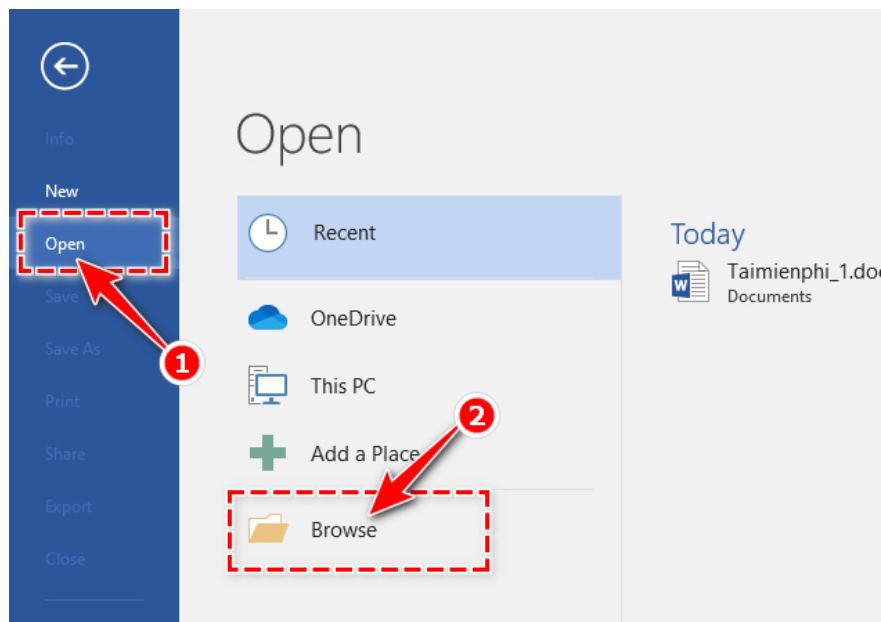
Method 1: Use the content recovery feature

By default, recent Office versions have a built-in feature to restore edited content. However, whether this feature works effectively or not depends greatly on how you set up the time to automatically save text.

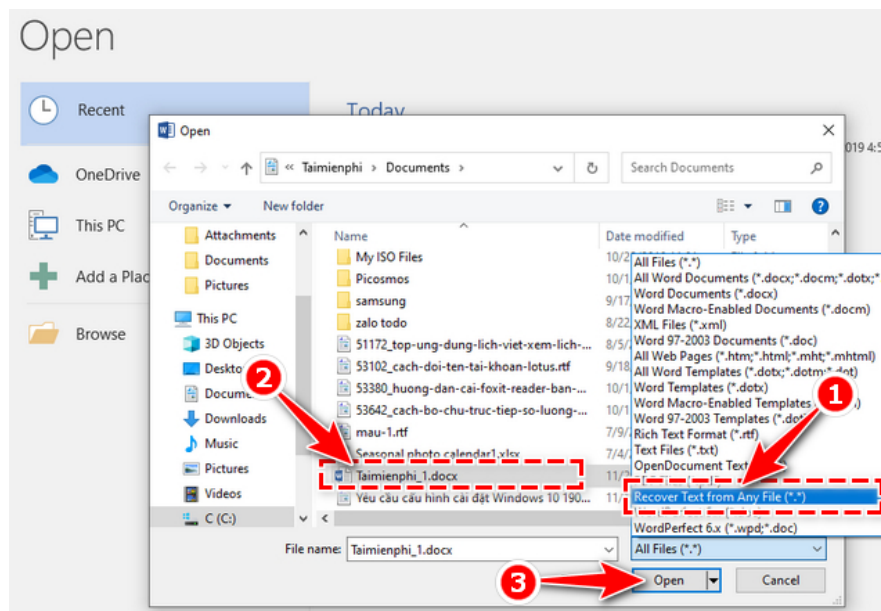
Step 1: Open any Word file as usual, then select **File** .



Step 2 : Click on **Open** in the function list, select **Browser** .



Step 3 : In the **Open window** , find the path to the folder where you saved the corrupted file. In the **File display options** dialog box, change the setting to **Recover Text from Any File(*.*)** . Then you choose **Open** .



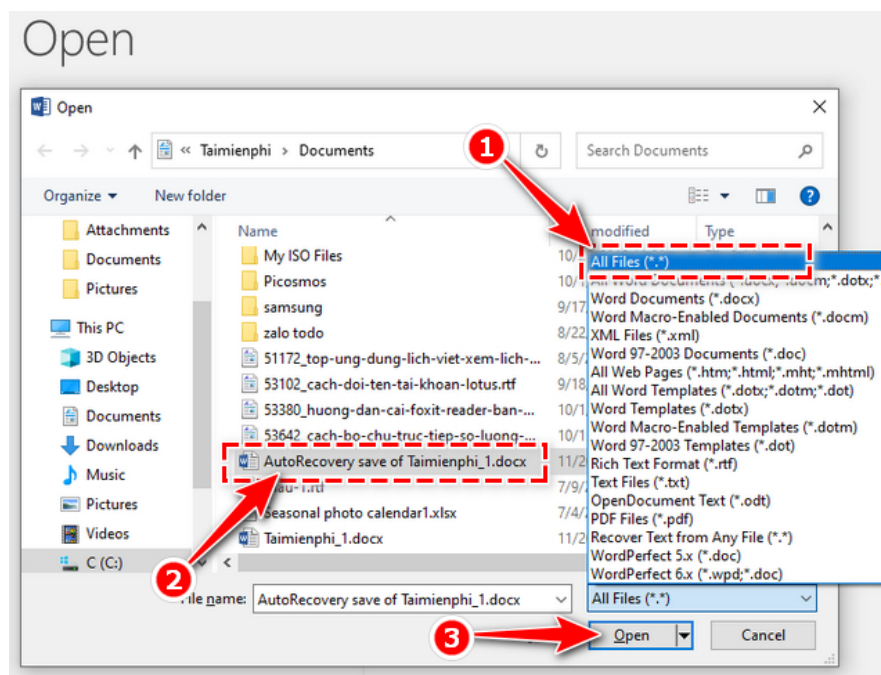
Method 2: Exploit the automatic backup feature In fact

, this is another way to effectively exploit the **Auto-save document** feature of Word software.

Step 1 : You also **open Word** and click **File** .

Step 2 : Click the **Open** button , and find the path to the folder where you saved the corrupted file.

Step 3 : Click the **File display options** dialog box and change the setting to **All Files** . Find the file named "**AutoRecovery save of,** ", click and select **Open** .

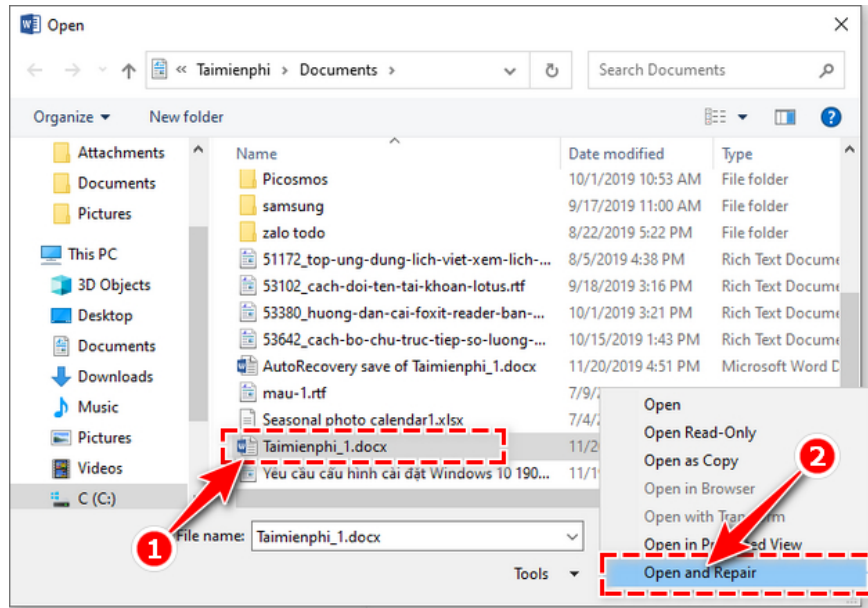


Method 3: Use the file error correction feature.

With this method, you will force Word to forcefully open the corrupted file. Normally you will only be able to get back a part, but not the entire content of the file.

Step 1: Similar to the above methods, **open Word software** , then click **File** and select **Open** .

Step 2: **Select the file** you want to open, then click **the arrow icon** next to the **Open** button and select **Open and Repair** .



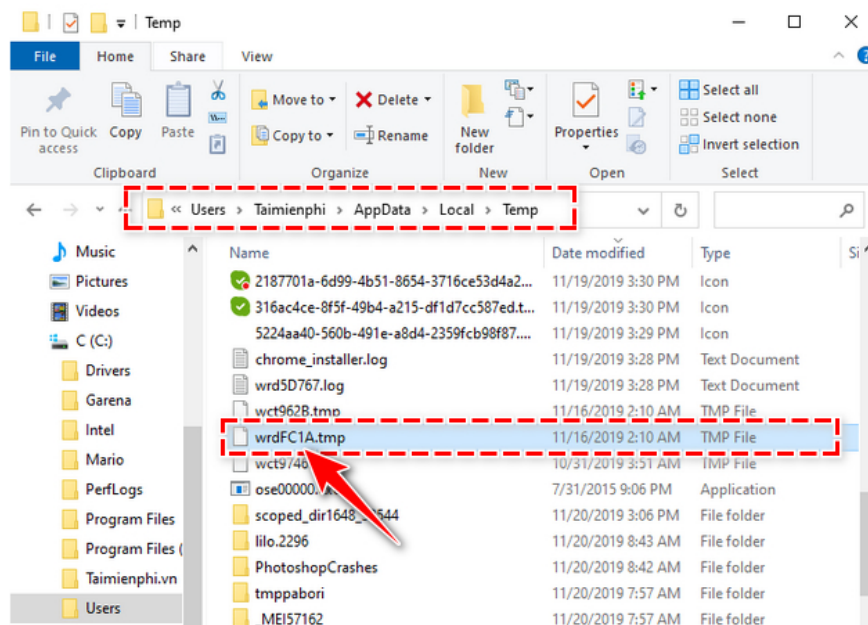
Method 4: Search in the Temp folder

If you cannot search for any files with Word, try checking the Temp folder, which contains temporary files of the operating system.

Step 1: Open **File Explorer** on your computer and access the following path:

C:UsersYour_computer_nameAppDataLocalTemp.

For example: C:UsersTaimienphiAppDataLocalTemp



Step 2: Here, you will find many files with different formats, but for now you only need to pay attention to files in **TMP** or **WBK** format with names set in the following format: **wrdxxxx.tmp** : Memo table of a regular Word file . **wrfxxxx.tmp**: Clipboard of a Word file. **wraxxxx.tmp**: Auto-recovery memo pad of a Word file. **xxxx.wbk**: Complete backup file of a certain Word file. **Note:** XXXX is the default number sequence, automatically set by the system for the file, you do not need to care. **Step 3:** Open **all** files in **TMP** or **WBK** format to find the correct Word file containing the content you need.
