Manufacturers in general and Samsung in particular are "notorious" for integrating their software into their phones. The biggest drawback is that manufacturers are adding more bloatware to their phones and uninstalling bloatware is not that simple.

However, thanks to the more 'cunning' of a developer at XDA, you can easily remove all bloatware on your Samsung Galaxy S7 or S7 Edge using scripts. Not only that, this script can optimize some other issues such as phone cooling, faster and more efficient performance.

In order for this script to work properly, you first need to root your Galaxy S7 or S7 Edge phone. Next download and run the **.bat** file on the script.

## I. Root your Samsung Galaxy S7 or S7 Edge phone

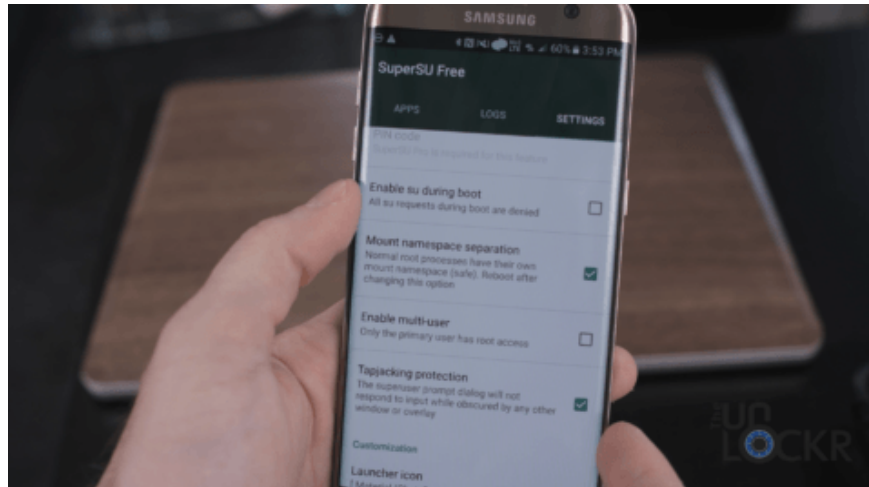
This is the first step to remove Bloatware applications on your Samsung Galaxy S7 or S7 Edge phone.

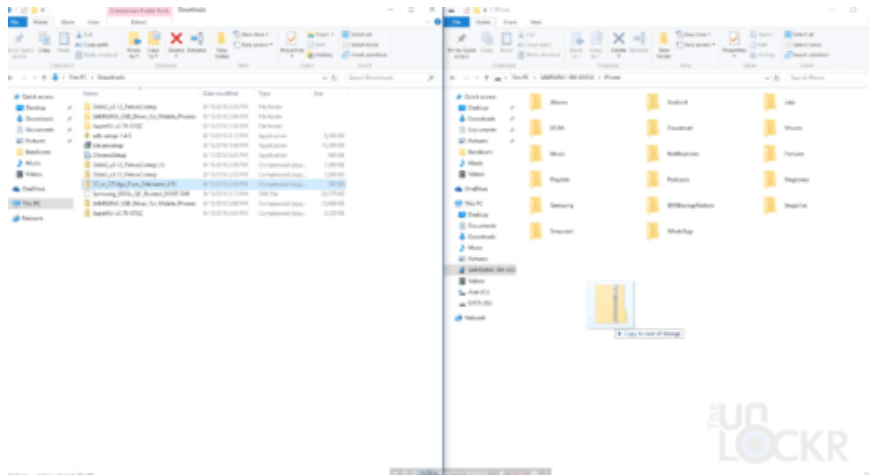
## II. Install Debloater Script

In addition to eliminating all of Samsung's bloatware, this script also solves a range of issues including overheating phones, improved CPU performance, and a number of other issues.

1. On your Samsung Galaxy S7 or S7 Edge phone, open the SuperSU application (the application you downloaded during the root of Galaxy S7 or S7 Edge), then click **Settings** and turn off the **Enable SU During Boot option.** in the **Security** section.



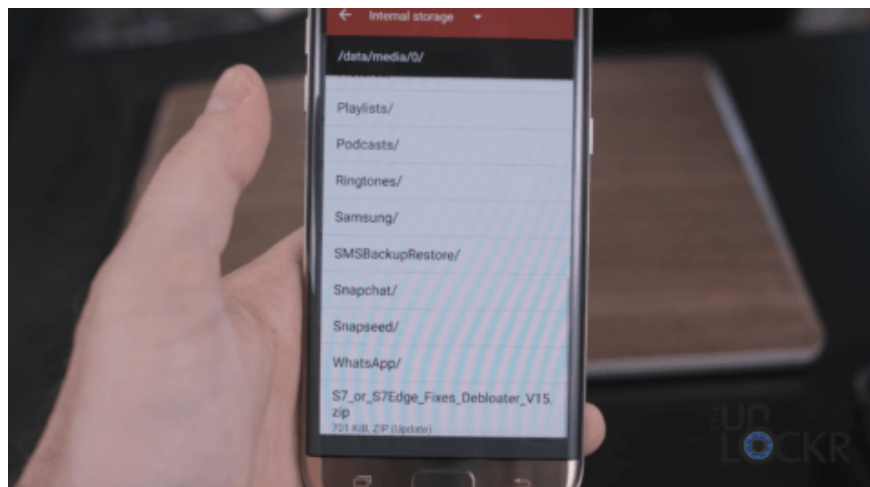
1. Download SuperSU installer to your computer and install it here.
2. Next access Play Store, then find and install the **Flashfire** app.
  1. Download Flashfire to your computer and install it here.
3. Download the Debloater Script for your specific device under **Recommend Next Steps** here on XDA and save it on the Desktop computer screen.
4. Use the USB cable to connect your phone to the computer, then copy the **debloater.zip** file to the phone's internal memory.



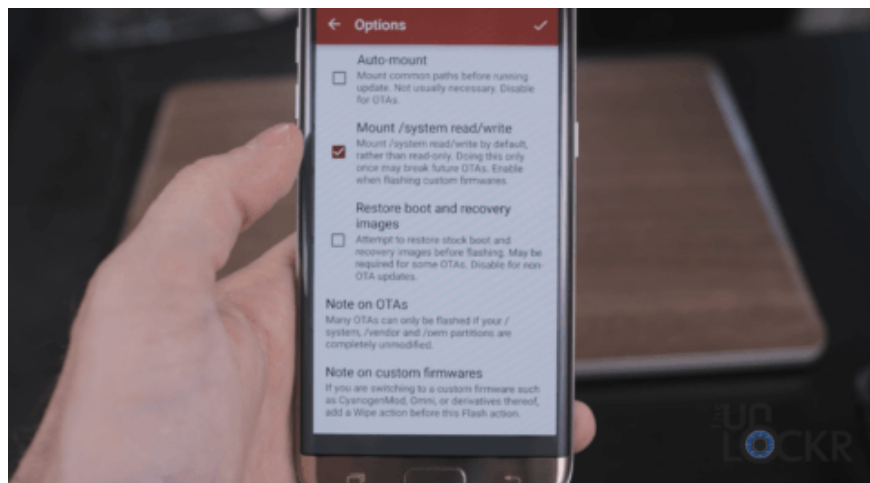
5. Disconnect your phone from your computer, then open the Flashfire app on your phone, click **the + icon** and select **Flash Zip** or **OTA** .



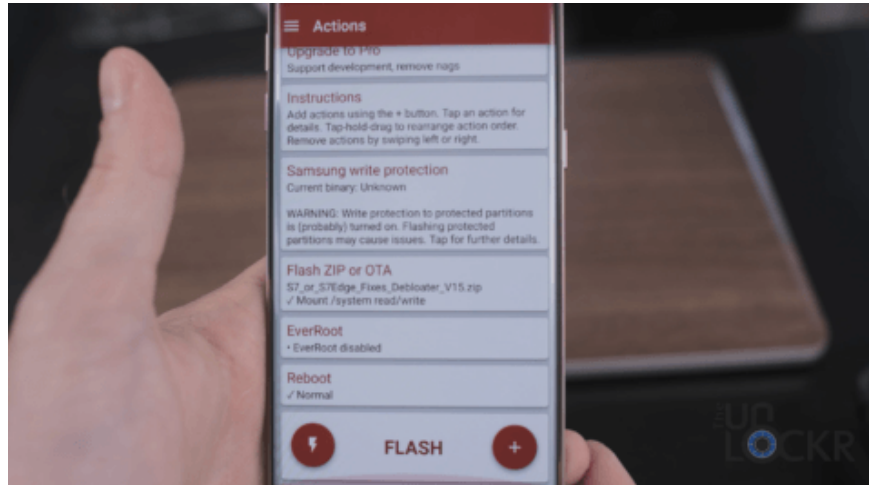
6. Select **debloater.zip** .



7. In the **Options** window, select **Mount System Read / Write** and make sure the remaining options are unchecked.



8. Click to select **Flash** and it will flash and restart several times.
