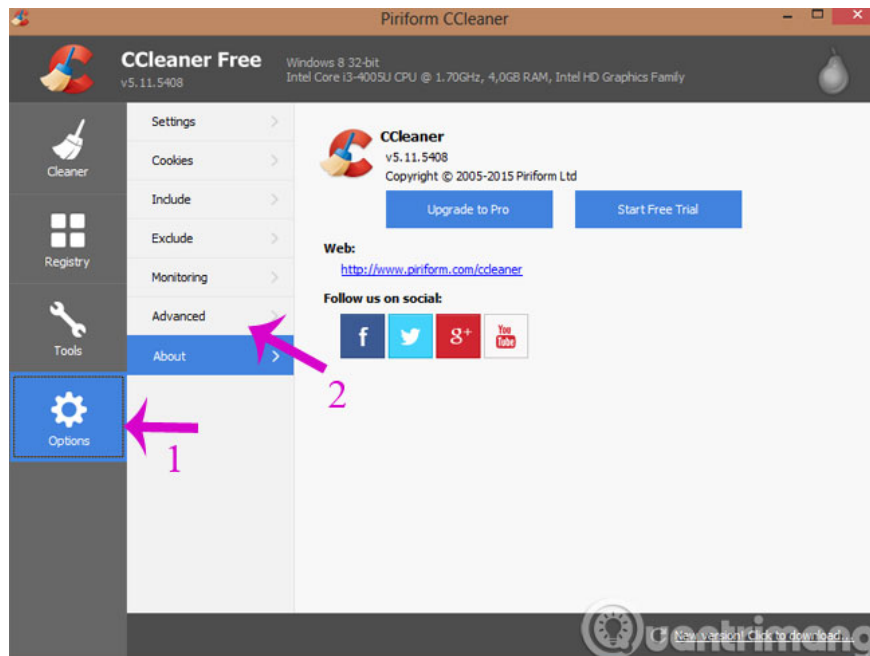


# Remove CCleaner's annoying messages in 2 steps

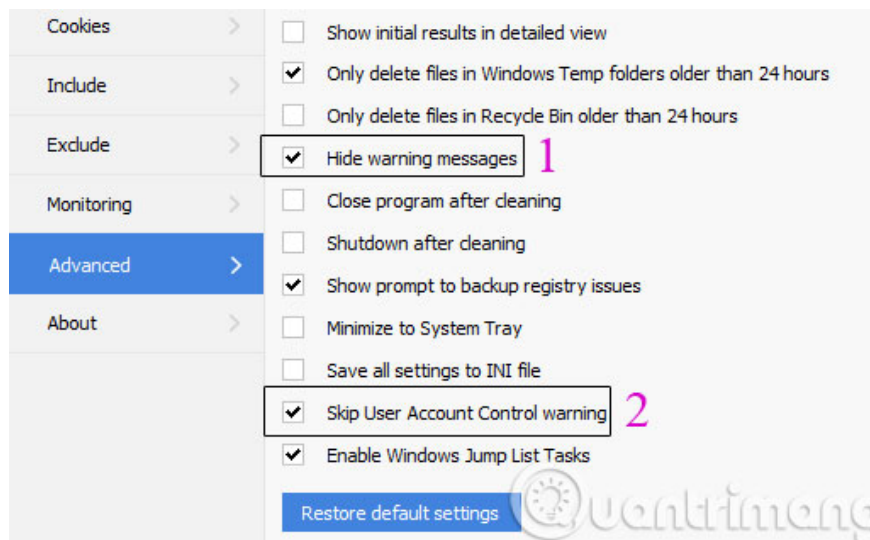

**Step 1** : From CCleaner's interface, click the **Options** menu and then select **Advanced**



**Step 2** : In the **Advanced** window, check the 2 options

1. **Hide warning messages** : Hide message notifications
2. **Skip User Account Control warning** : Keep control of user account notifications



So, with just 2 simple steps, you have eliminated the annoying messages of CCleaner.

1. Change language on CCleaner
2. Instructions for using CCleaner effectively
3. Activate CCleaner's operating mode with multiple accounts on Windows
