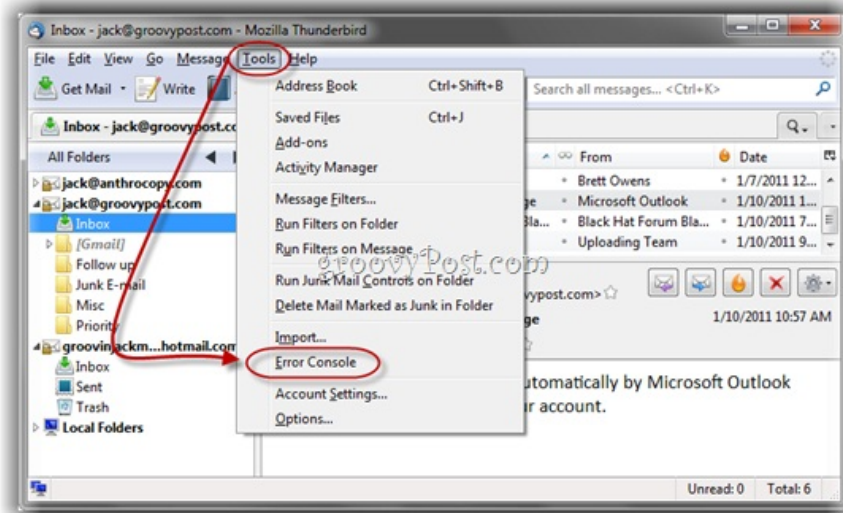

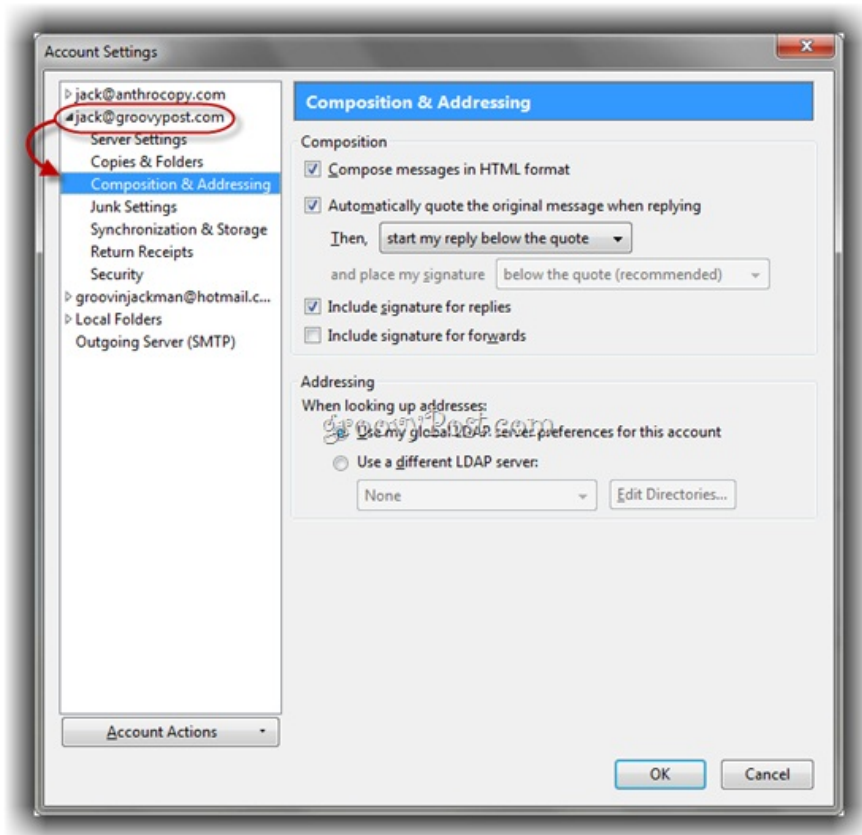

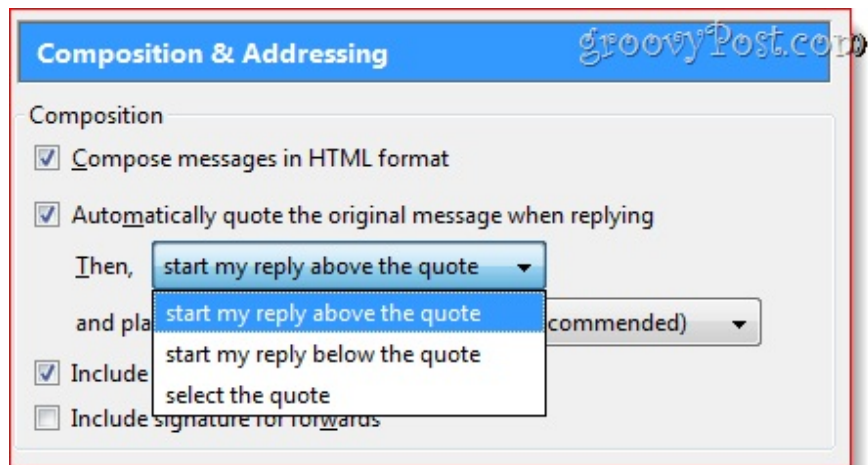
First, you select **Tools> Account Settings** in Thunderbird:



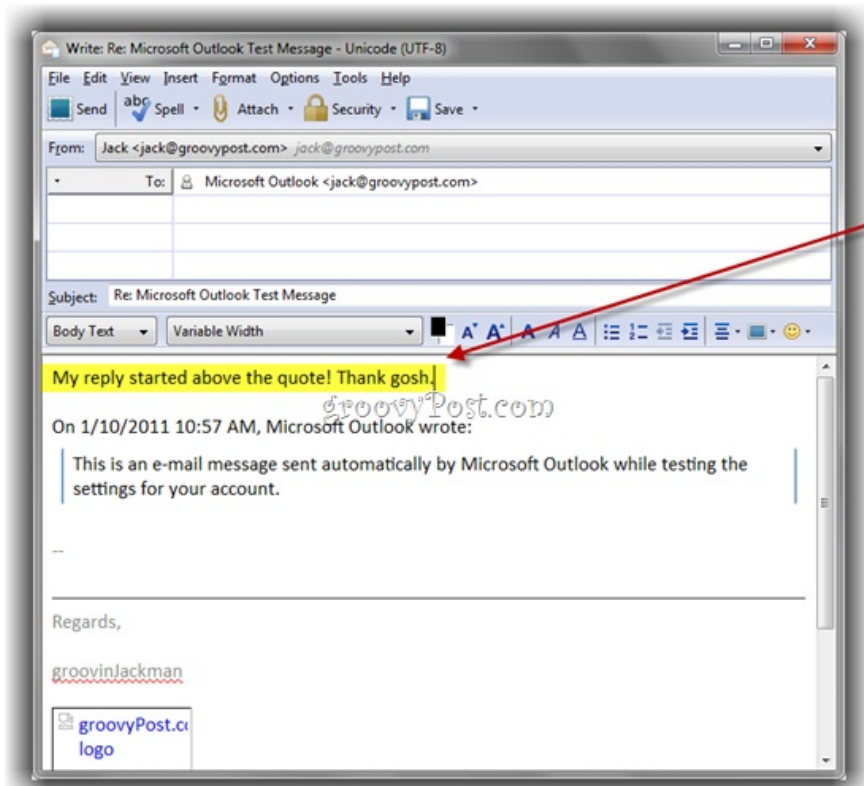
Select dedicated settings for each account and select **Composition & Addressing** :



Check the box **Automatically quote the original message when replying** and select **start my reply above the quote** in the **Then .** section. Then click **OK** :



And from now on, all emails replying with the quote will display as follows:
