*' This is an old kerosene lamp, about 900 years old, the lamp has signs of corrosion, old, mossy, the mouth of the lamp sticking with soot ' - Sa'ar Ganor, the archaeologist of the district Ashkelon said.*

The lamp was washed up by the waves and lying on the sand for a long time, no one had ever seen it before.

Ashkelon explains: *'This kerosene lamp is an ancient object, reflecting the long-standing characteristic of the commercial life of the ancient local inhabitants about 900 years ago. The lights are lit, hanging in the ports*

*every night when the ancient residents of Isarel import and export trade and purchase goods through the seaport*  
' .
