

Reset Windows password using USB

You can easily reset your Windows password using a USB drive if you happen to forget your Windows password on your computer. Let TipsMake guide you on how to reset your Windows password using a USB drive with the iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro software.

To easily reset your Windows password using a USB drive, and for anyone to use, TipsMake recommends iSeePassword Windows. iSeePassword, whose full name is iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro, allows you to remove passwords from any operating system without many steps. iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro has two modes: resetting Windows passwords via **USB** or via **DVD**.



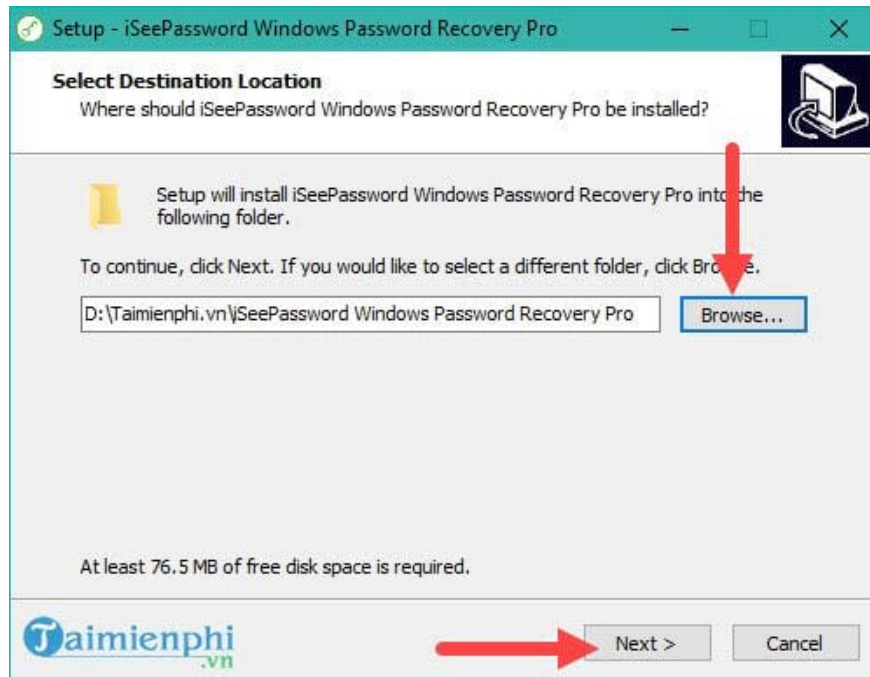
Although the two methods are similar, TipsMake will guide you **on resetting your Windows password using a USB drive** because of its common use and because most laptops nowadays no longer have optical drives.

Instructions on how to reset your Windows password using a USB drive.

Prepare:

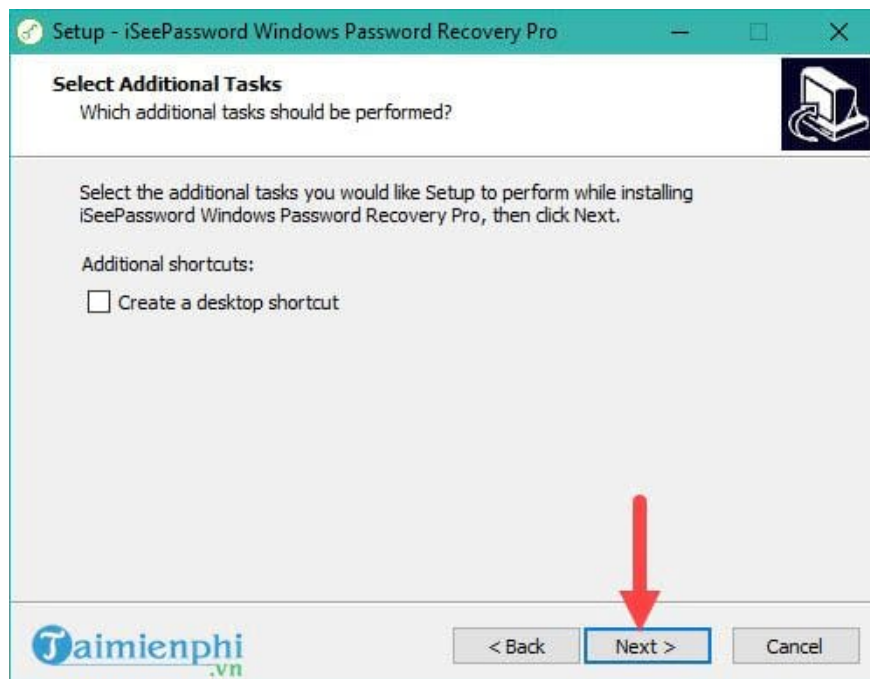
- A USB drive with a minimum capacity of 4 GB.
- Download the iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro software [here](#).

Step 1: After the iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro download is complete, double-click the file to install it.



Please note that if you want to choose a different location to save the software, click **Browse**.

Step 2: Next, select **Next**, and you can check the "**Create a desktop shortcut**" box if you want to create an icon for your desktop.



Step 3: Finally, click **Install** to allow the system to install the software, and then we can use iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro to reset your Windows password using a USB drive.



Please wait a moment for the software to finish installing, then click **Finish** to open the software.



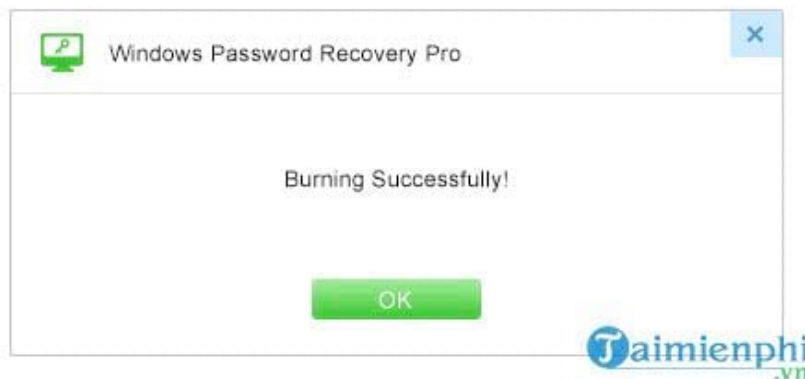
Step 4: The iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro software is very simple to use; you just need to use a DVD or plug in a USB drive to start using it. Here, we're resetting the Windows password using a USB drive, so we'll plug the USB drive into the computer and select " **Burn USB**" .



All old data on the USB drive will be deleted, so readers should copy any old data they have out.



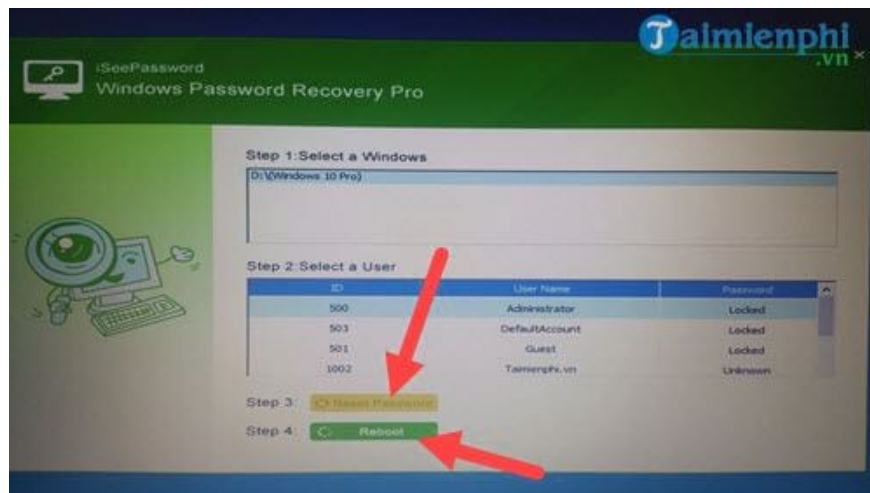
The burning process to reset your Windows password using a USB drive is complete. Click **OK** and restart your computer.



Step 5: Enter the BIOS to select the USB drive you just burned the software to. If you don't know how to access the BIOS for your specific computer model, you can find instructions here .



Step 6: Finally, simply select the username that appears on the screen and click **Reset Password** . After successfully resetting your Windows password using the USB drive, click **reboot** to restart your computer.



After the above steps, restart your device and you should be able to access accounts that are locked by passwords or that you forgot. Let TipsMake know if you successfully complete the process!

In fact, there are many tools that can help you log into your computer when you forget your password, but iSeePassword Windows Password Recovery Pro is one of the solutions you should try because it's fast and simple. However, TipsMake advises you to set a password that is difficult to guess but easy to remember. Also, save your password on your phone or in a notebook to prevent having to use other methods to log into Windows when you forget your password .
