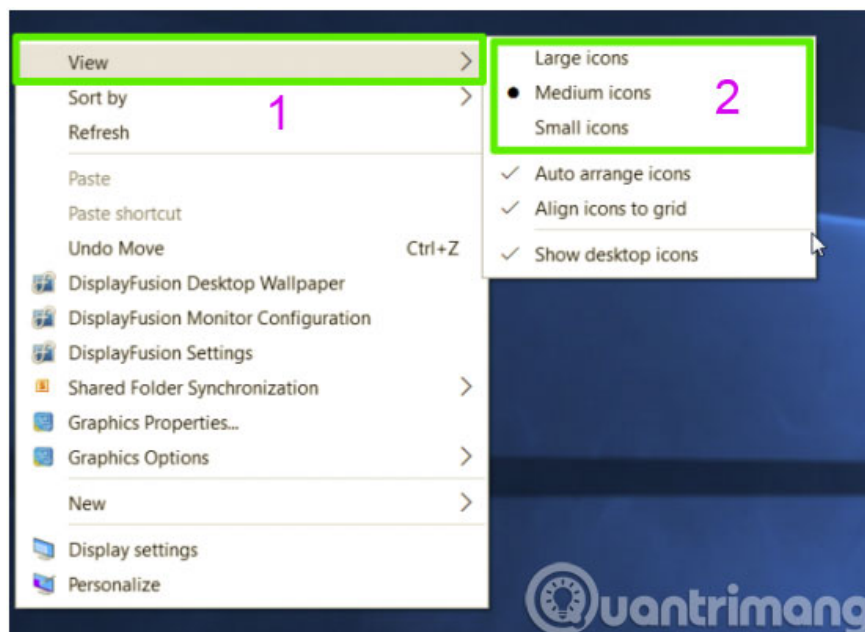

Change the icon size on the desktop

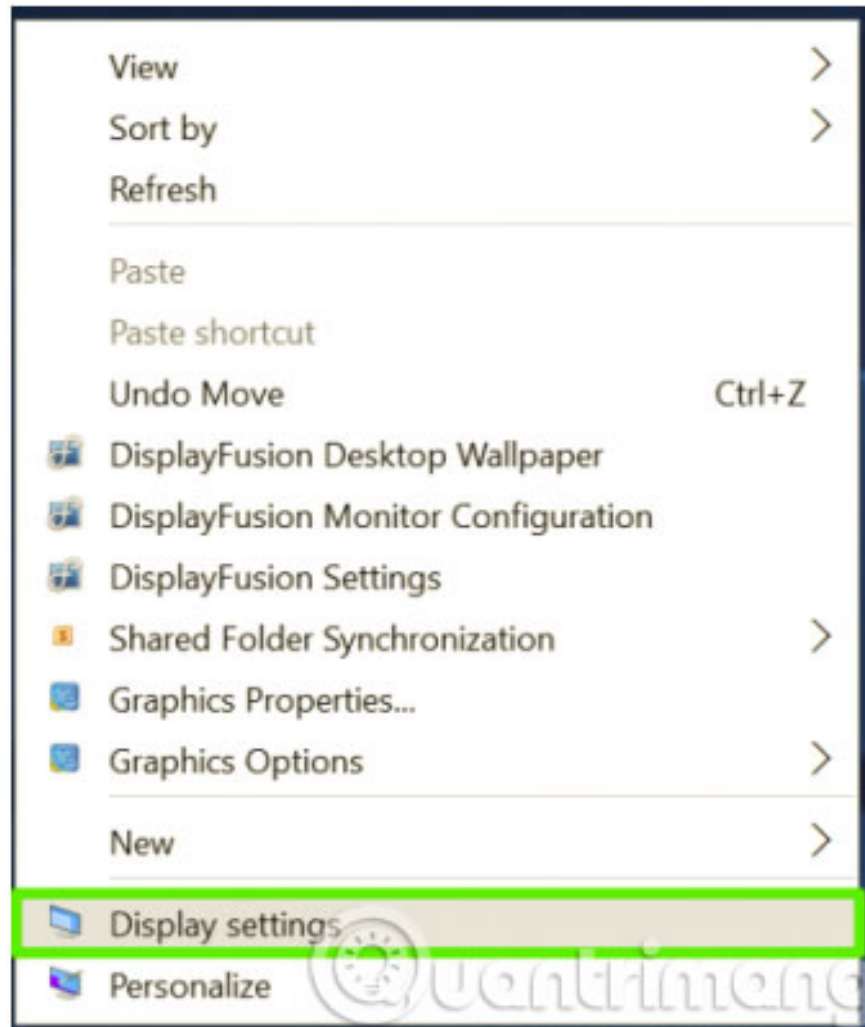
At the desktop, right-click and select **View** . Here there will be 3 options for you **Large icons** , **Medium icons** and **Small icons** . The default of Windows 10 will be **Medium icons** .



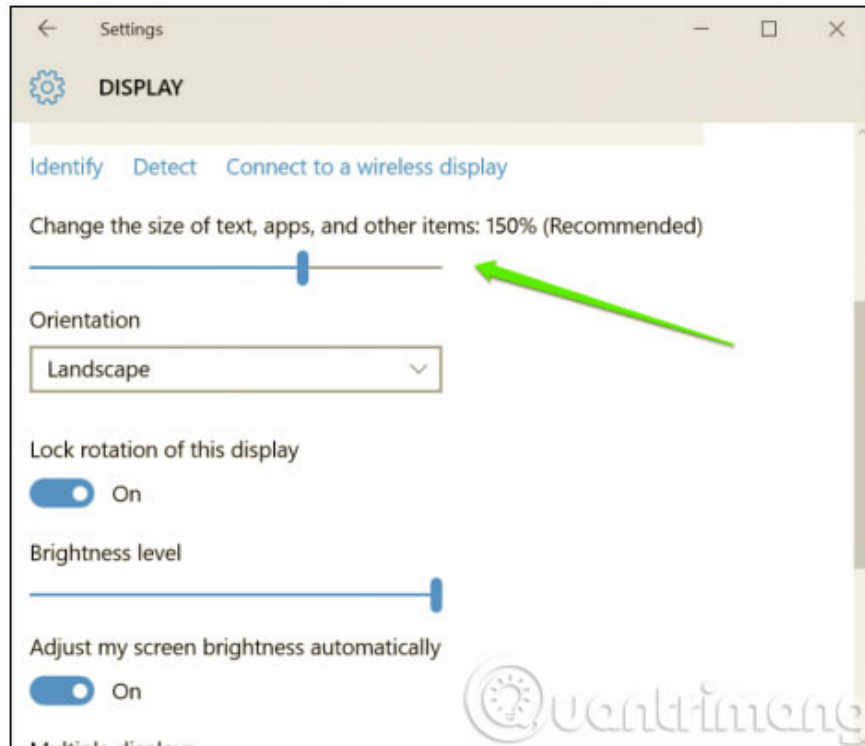
Change the size of icons on the Taskbar

In case you want to resize the icons displayed in the taskbar in the way you want, the following way will help you. But this way will also change the size of text, applications and other content on Windows 10.

You can also right-click on the Desktop and select **Display Settings**



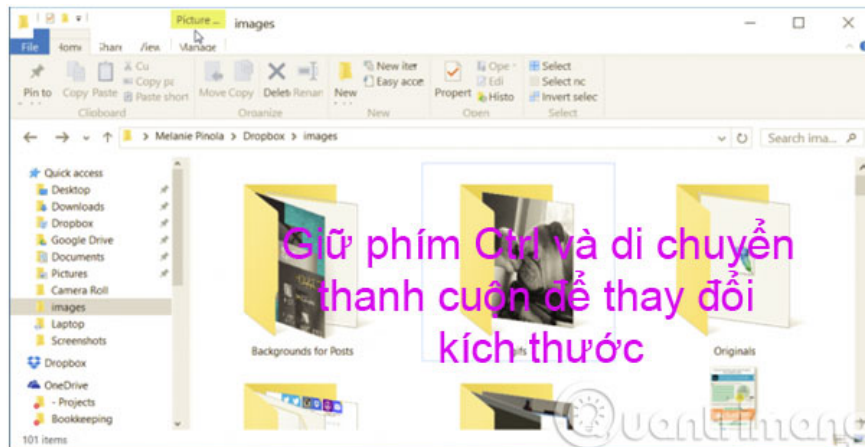
Next in the **Change the size . section** , move the slider to change the desired size



Finally click the **Apply** button at the bottom of the Display window. Windows may require you to log out and log back on for changes to be applied. This setting not only makes the icons in the taskbar slightly larger, but it also makes the text larger in applications such as **Microsoft Edge** and Calendar, as well as in the notification window on Windows 10.

Change the size of icons in File Explorer

If you want larger, smaller or thumbnail images in a specific folder in **File Explorer**, do the following. You just need to access the folder you want to change the display size, hold down the **Ctrl** key and then use the scroll bar to zoom in or out the display size of the files and folders inside.



Although File Explorer will remember your last setting when you open this folder again, this setting will only apply to a specific folder, so you will have to adjust each folder you want to change. size shown on the system.
