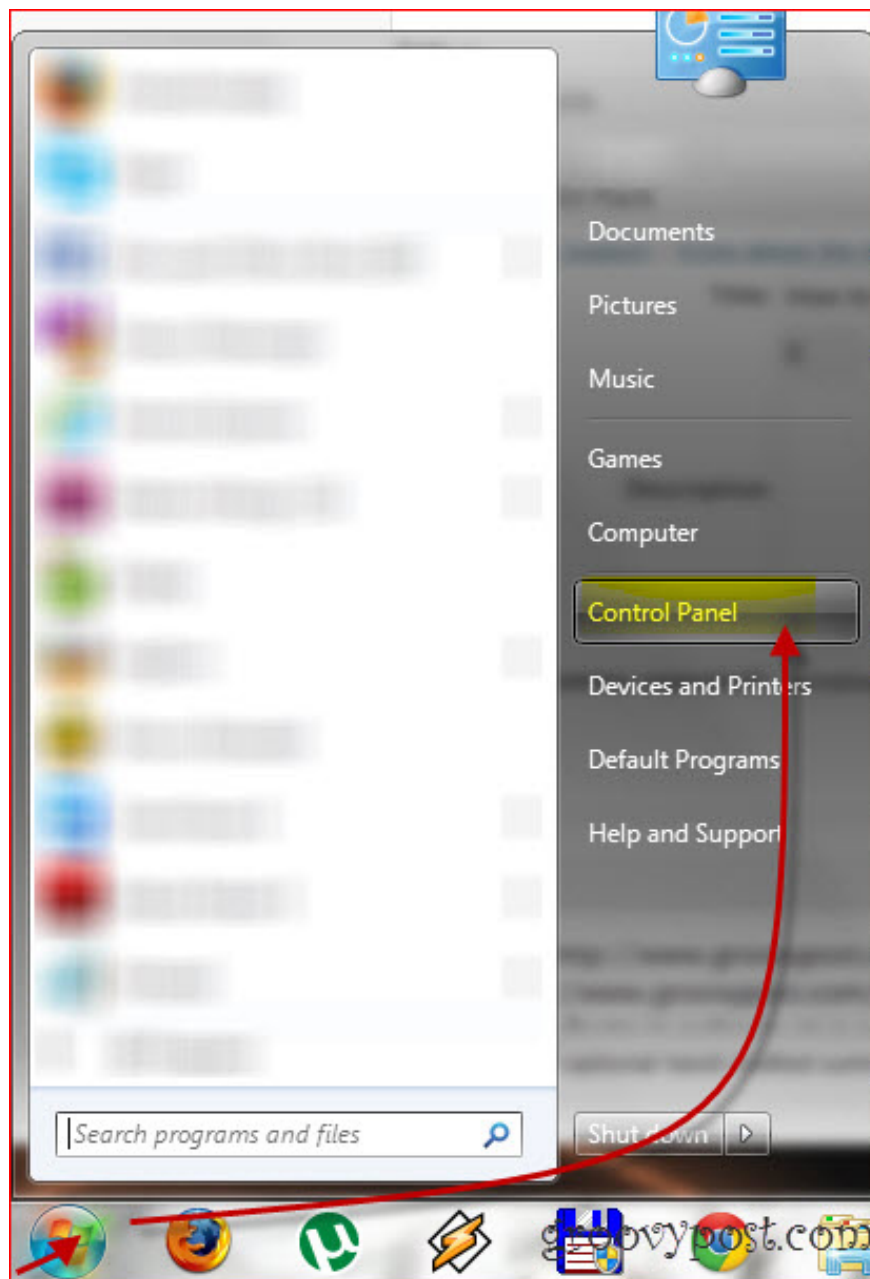


# Restore the default font set of Windows 7

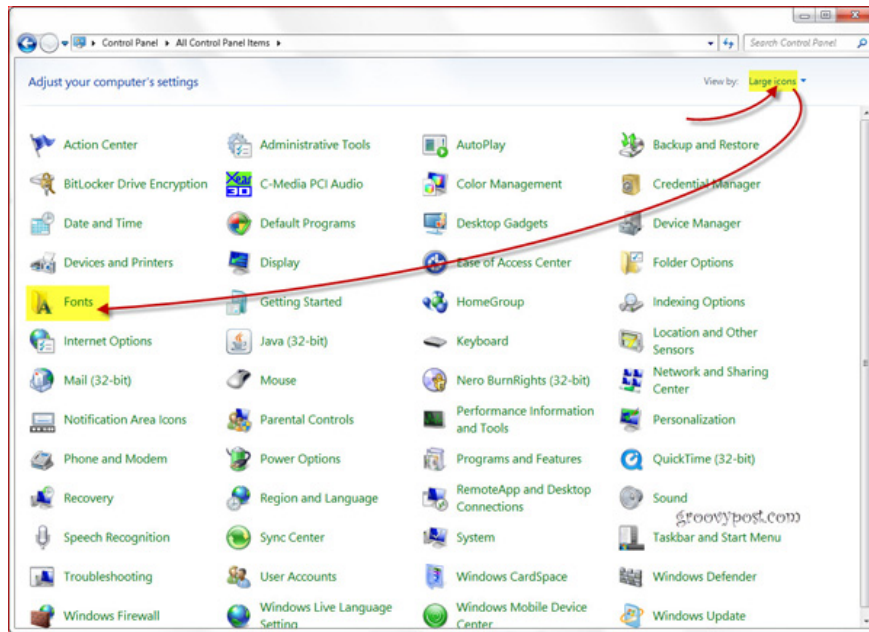

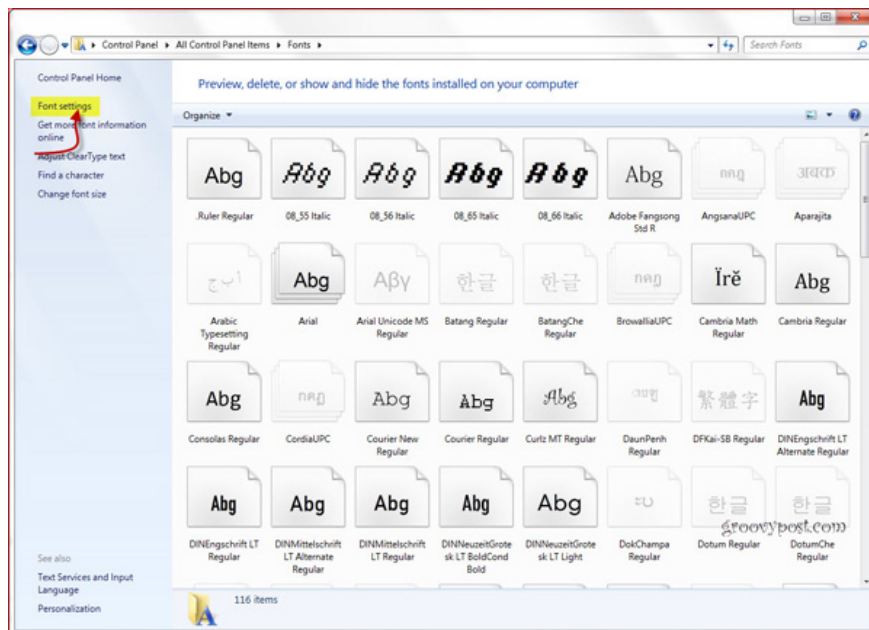
First, open the **Start Menu > Control Panel:**



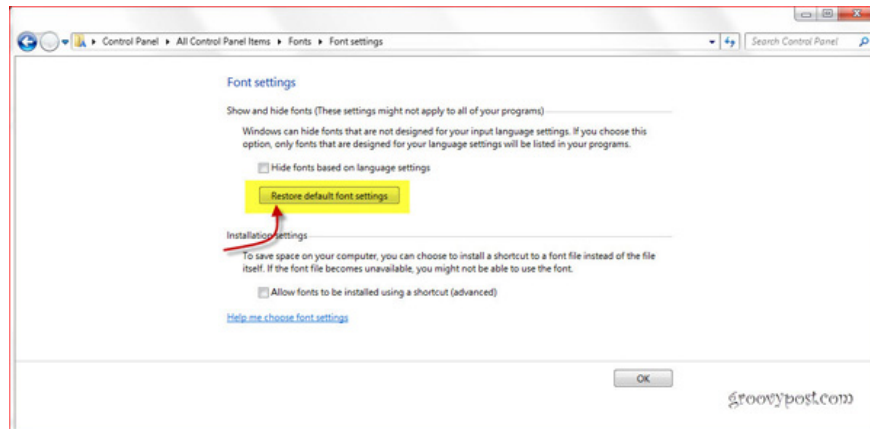
Here, we can change the view to facilitate the **View by** sort function , then select **Fonts** :



The next window displays, here you will see the entire font of the operating system, click the **Font settings** button :



Select the next **Restore default font settings**:



Thus, with just a few steps above, we have completed the restoration of the default font system of the operating system.
