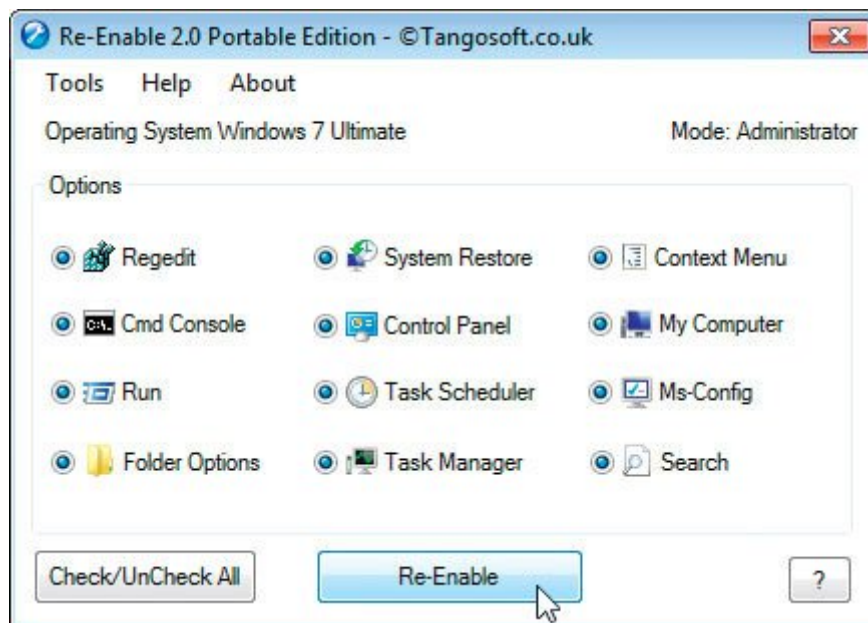


Restore tools for Windows 7

Like previous versions of Windows, viruses after attacking Windows 7 will immediately lock all key applications so that users cannot destroy them.

Like previous versions of Windows, viruses after attacking Windows 7 will immediately block all key applications so that users cannot destroy them . If you are a person who is knowledgeable about the registry, you can easily 'not catch the virus' but it is best to download the **Re-Enable Tool 2.0** utility.

This is a free utility, runs independently, requires no installation, so it is very convenient for storage and use.



Since the Re-Enable Tool is just a utility that helps 'clean up' the virus's consequences, it cannot help you to remove the virus yourself, but you need to perform a virus scan with an antivirus software before you use it. Use the Re-Enable Tool. After downloading to your computer, run the Re-Enable v2 Portable.exe file to start the program. From the main interface of the program, you will see options to bring the names of system tools like *Regedit* , *System Restore* , *Folder Options* , *Task Manager* . To re-enable these tools, you just need to tick Select the empty box in front of its name and click on the Re-Enable button.

In addition, you can turn on other features in Windows 7 by going to the **Tools** menu. Here you will find options to help restore and repair features such as *Safe Mode* , *Host* (Internet access management file), return the default file, folder, and find properties. delete Autorun.inf files on the hard disk .
