Decipher the magic screen through David Copperfield's Great Wall

In fact, David took advantage of the light to fool the follower's eyesight in this performance.

The key to this performance is the ultra-powerful rear projection lamp that shines directly onto the white curtain to reveal David's shadow. But actually due to the angle of the lamp, the light only brightens part of the curtain.

In the audience's view, David entered the iron frame covered by the curtain. In fact, there was another person who looked like David had been waiting there. While David pretended to go on stage and quickly retreated to a corner without lights, the viewers believed that the magician was going through the real wall when David quickly fell into a secret room below. That is the small staircase that is close to this iron frame.
