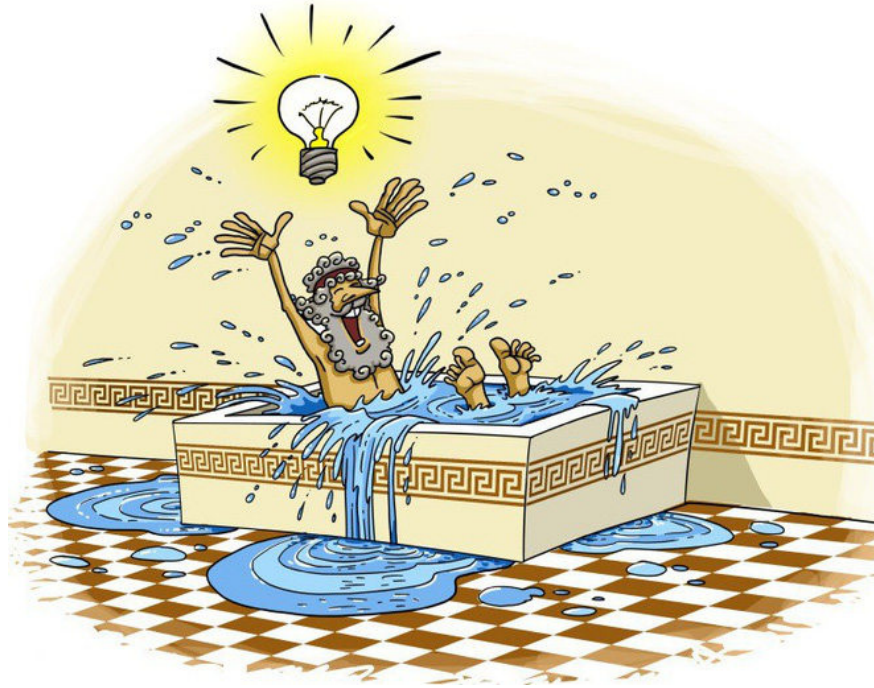
1. The Trojan horse
