

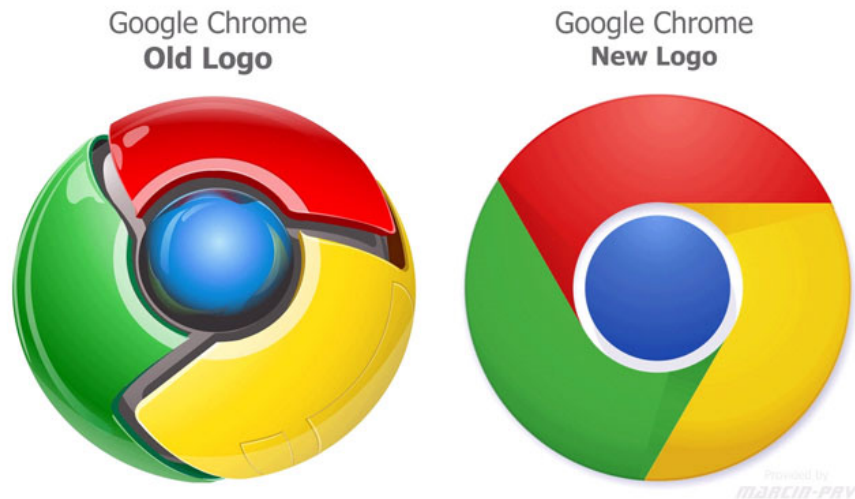
Revealing new features of Chrome browser

After announcing a development schedule for Firefox, Mozilla launched the 'Aurora' channel that allows early testing of upcoming features and improvements on the browser. Meanwhile, Microsoft's IE9 browser is also not outdone when less than 1 month of launching IE9, Microsoft has allowed users to download IE 10 browser preview. This version promises much improvement in speed. , optimizing HTML5 web standards, CSS3 and 3D content conversion capabilities.

So, just last week, Google announced there were dozens of changes to the internal browser and user interface of the Chrome browser. The most prominent among them must mention:



1. 'SPDY' speed

Although it appeared on Chrome browser since mid-January but now the SPDY protocol is really complete. SPDY is a small change to the HTTP protocol to transmit web content with the lowest latency. According to Google, thanks to 'SPDY' the Chrome browser download time has decreased by 64%. However, these improvements can now only be realized when using Chrome to access Google's own websites. All downloadable versions of the Chrome browser currently support the SPDY feature.

2. Increase security

Targeting business users, Google also made some changes to the content privacy policy. In particular, system administrators can use Chrome to block specific types of content, such as plug-ins, images, fonts, script code, and more. In addition to the new warnings Google announced earlier this month, users are also warned of potentially dangerous download links.

3. Touch Tabs

'Touch Tabs' allows users to select multiple home pages in the style of application icons like on the smartphone application screen. Meanwhile, just a few days ago, Google said, adding 'Recently Closed' option to the browser to list those sites in a pop-up window.

4. Tab Tab Bar

The new scroll bar button has been added to Chrome's tab section. As a result, users can access all tabs by moving the scroll bar (the arrow next to the tabs in the image above). Thus users can open multiple tabs without minimizing the tab view space.

5. Improve WebKit

Google has improved the WebKit browser mechanism in Chrome to allow users to quickly view PDF files in print preview mode.

According to research firm Net Applications, in January, Chrome accounted for 10% of the worldwide browser market share, and in March, it reached 11.57% of the browser market share. Global.

Therefore, when the browser war continues to be hot, users will get many new features, as well as improvements on the browser to surf the web faster, more efficiently and safely.
