

# Revealing the last Call of Duty superstar returned to World War II

The first images of the Call of Duty final version were revealed by Activision, with the space returning to the cradle of COD: World War II.

In November 2017, the final version of the **famous FPS game Call of Duty** will be released. Unlike recent versions, this edition will return to the inherent core of COD. Instead of space battles have become so popular in the last few years, the latest Call of Duty will return to World War II. This is what you can expect from Call of Duty: WWII. First of all, look through the game trailer.

The player plays Ronald "Red" Daniels, a private soldier in the US military. Red is already a member of the 1st Infantry Division. Red's duties will put him in **the most famous battles of World War II** , including D-Day and the Bulge battle.



Here is Activision's description of the story in the game: "*Join the allies from England and France, stretching from Normandy beach to the liberation area in France and finally to Germany, the army. must fight with diverse characters to win*".



Currently only the campaign mode is revealed, but fans can look forward **to the online multiplayer mode** . Activision said that the most popular, multi-player mode in the series - will also return to the "roots" of the COD brand. Instead of creating a completely bogus multiplayer game, the latest COD version will focus on re-creating WWII-style battles.



Activision describes as follows: " *Players will face chaotic battles with classic arsenal on familiar locations of World War II, bringing the most intense of the war, bringing people at the same time. play into the most intense and emotional battle in history* " .

It seems that there will be a lack of air battles and return to the battle of many players on the ground. Besides the two main game modes - a campaign player and many players - there will be **a new cooperative play mode that has not been revealed** .



Here's what we know about co-op mode at the moment: " *New and completely co-operative collaboration mode, surprisingly new standalone experience with moments dramatic* ". Maybe the campaign mode will be completely integrated to play with friends. This mode is quite similar to Spec Ops already in some previous versions, except that it is based on more plot.



**In terms of graphics, the game will be better than the previous version.** Although the graphics are very beautiful, we only see them now applied to scenes in Western Europe. D-Day or the Bulge battle was also seen in the previous COD but few scenes in Asia or North Africa were redone. Perhaps players will have to wait more.

The game is scheduled for release on November 3, 2017 on Xbox One, PlayStation 4 and PC systems.
