

# Revelations suggest that the iPhone 13 will not be released

It is speculated that Apple will launch the iPhone 12S this year, skipping the number 13 to continue launching the iPhone 14 or 15 for 2022.

Apple is still half a year away from launching a new generation iPhone, but speculation about the design of the **iPhone 13** still makes the tech world seething.

Apple has a history of skipping some numbers when naming the iPhone. For example, in 2016, the company launched the iPhone 7. The next year is the iPhone 8, 8 Plus and iPhone X - the special edition celebrates the 10th anniversary of the iPhone's birth. People didn't see the iPhone 9 at all.



This is because for the iPhone X, Apple also uses the letter X and says "iPhone ten", to logically match the 10th anniversary of the iPhone. Therefore, the designation "iPhone 9" is not suitable for this purpose.



However, fans of defective apples also have their own views. Many Twitter users explain by saying "seven ate nine" (number 7 has eaten number 9).



This pun is strongly supported by the phrase "seven ate nine" has the same pronunciation as "seven eight nine".



Therefore, if Apple ignores the iPhone 13 to launch any particular iPhone 14, it is not a surprise. That particular iPhone could be the foldable iPhone version that many people speculate recently.
