

Review Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8: The best business laptop

Lenovo's ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 brings a new design with a few interesting additions. A few adjustments will make this model more attractive than ever for business users, as well as everyday users.

Launched just a few days before CES 2020, Lenovo's ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 brings a new design with a few interesting additions.

The ThinkPad X1 Carbon has been the best business notebook for several years thanks to its durable yet portable design, high-quality components, and extensive features.

Price of Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon

Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 is expected to launch in 2020 with a starting price of \$ 1,499.

Design

The Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 may at first look exactly the same as the Gen 7 version, but a few interesting design tweaks will make things a little bit better.



Appearance of the Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8

The lid of the Gen 8 version is made of carbon fiber, highlighting the laptop's durable materials.

Lenovo has also moved the X1 Carbon decal from the lower right corner of the lid to the position just below the ThinkPad logo.

The Carbon X1 Gen 8 looks identical to the previous version. You'll still find the red border on the pointing stick and extra touchpad button of the X1 Carbon. The X1 Carbon does not have the thinnest bezels, but so it can accommodate an optional IR camera and ThinkShutter webcam case.

This ultraportable is 0.6 inches (1.5cm) thick and weighs only 2.4 pounds (1.1kg). The X1 Carbon retains the MIL-STD specification rating, meaning it can withstand harsh conditions.

Port on Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8

Despite its slim design, the X1 Carbon still offers a range of ports. On the right is the USB 3.1 Type-A port, located next to the Kensington lock. Looking around, you'll see two Thunderbolt 3 ports, a second USB 3.1 port, HDMI input and a headphone / mic jack on the left. There is also an exclusive docking port.

Screen

The ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 will offer several different 14-inch screen options. New for this year is a 500 nit FHD (anti-glare) touch screen with PrivacyGuard or built-in privacy filter to limit viewing angles.

You also have a variety of 1080p and 4K options, including a 14-inch, FHD or non-touch screen with up to 400 nit brightness and WQHD panel (2560 x 1440 pixels) with brightness up to 300 nit.

If you judge image quality over battery life, it's better to choose a 4K (UHD) screen with 500 nit brightness.

Keyboard and touchpad

In fact, the new version promises to improve the keyboard with the new UC (Unified Communication) keys, so you can quickly answer and end video conference calls, as well as mute / unmute the mic.

This new model has the same favorite curved keys and the displacement level is 1.5 mm.

Specifications of Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8

Powering the ThinkPad X1 Carbon is the 10th-generation Intel Comet Lake processor. Lenovo has not yet released the exact information, but the X1 Carbon can be configured with a six-core Core i7 CPU. If it's a Core i7-10710U CPU, then you can expect lightning-fast performance.

What's even more interesting is that Lenovo says the X1 Carbon will be available with vPro. Designed for IT administrators, Intel's remote management platform is currently not available on 10th generation processors. These processors can be paired with up to 16GB of RAM and a 2TB PCIe SSD. .

Battery life

The ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 has a 51Wh battery which is rated to last 10 to 18.5 hours on a single charge.

Lenovo made a few welcome changes to the Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 in 2020, including an updated design, new processor options, a more functional keyboard and a separate display screen. from.

The refined design and new screen options of the Lenovo ThinkPad X1 Carbon Gen 8 can make it a worthy successor to Lenovo's favorite business laptop model.
