

# Reviews OPPO Reno3: Elegant design, 4 rear cameras, water drop screen

Although it was launched globally two months ago, due to the complicated disease situation, OPPO Reno3 has been launched so far.

This machine has a lot of differences compared to its predecessor Reno2, which we will learn in the process of opening the OPPO Reno3 box below.



The box of the product is no longer 'too long' but has returned to a balanced design like other products of the same company. The outside of the box is decorated with ridges quite similar to the back that we will explore below.



In the box we have the standard 30W VOOC 3.0 dock and cable, which according to the announcement, can charge 50% battery in 30 minutes and full battery in 73 minutes.



Accompanied by a pair of earbud-style headphones, with the sound hole in green - the traditional color of OPPO.



Reno3 has two colors, 'Midnight Black' and the color we have here: Aurora Blue. In fact, we see more purple than green! The entire back has ray lines, quite slender, so you have to pay attention to see it.



The camera cluster is arranged vertically on the left, with the main camera 48 MP f / 1.8, telephoto camera 2x 13 MP f / 2.4, ultra-wide angle camera 13mm 8 MP f / 2.2 and a black and white sensor for dimensional measurement deep, for portrait photography. Regarding software, we have the ability to capture OPPO's new night is Ultra Night Mode and capture high resolution 108MP Ultra Clear Image.



The bottom is a small OPPO logo.



Unlike other brands that offer transparent plastic cases, OPPO offers Reno3 users a thick hard plastic case, designed by renowned fashion designer Jimmy Choo. The version I have on hand seems a bit feminine, but the company also has more 'pitiful' versions for boys.



The power button is painted green, located on the right edge.



2 volume rocker and SIM slot are moved to the left.



The bottom edge is a USB Type-C charging port that supports VOOC 3.0 and a 3.5mm music port.



Moving to the front, we see a 6.4 inch AMOLED screen with 1080 x 2400 resolution ratio of 20: 9. Perhaps you also realized that Reno3 no longer owns the shark fin selfie camera design that made the Reno product line, but turned this camera into a 'teardrop' cut on the screen. . This is the trend of all OPPO products in particular and the entire smartphone market in general.

There will be a lot of controversy in this regard, because the camera 'protruding' will help the screen to be free from defects, which helps to experience the fuller picture. In contrast, on-screen cameras like Reno3 and Find X2 will have an almost instant startup time, and will also last over time.



Next to the screen we will have an optical hand sensor, the speed is still 'lightning fast' just like other products of OPPO.



Taking a look at the configuration, Reno3 owns an 8-core Helio P90 processor, 8GB of RAM, 128GB of memory, a 4025mAh battery, uses Android 10 platform with ColorOS 7 interface - the new interface kit has also recently face on the Find X2 high-end model.



The *OPPO Reno3* is expected to go on sale on May 9.
