Here are 5 things to do if you want to save fuel.

1. Regular maintenance of vehicles



Regular maintenance of the vehicle is similar to that of our regular health check, it will help you find hidden diseases soon, as well as repair and replace components in time to help the car operate stably. In addition, this is the main method to help you limit the fuel consumption. A car in a well-maintained condition will always operate smoother, meaning that the car will be more fuel efficient.

In addition to maintaining the parts on the car, remember to replace the oil, oil filter and air filter regularly according to the manufacturer's instructions.

2. Change the way of driving



When riding a motorbike, you should not rev when going or going up a slope and still have some weak cars to pull, it will really be a waste of fuel. So learn to run slowly, you should maintain a stable speed, avoid braking, sudden acceleration. In urban roads, you need to keep a distance of about 2m from the front car, observe the red light remotely to slowly reduce the gas.

Turning off the engine when stopping the red light for more than 30 seconds not only saves fuel but also contributes to environmental protection. When the red light is stopped, the vehicle still consumes a certain amount of fuel when moving without turning off the engine.

Click number 2 or 3 if the traffic jam, number 4 with airway, mixed or number 1 when stop waiting for the red light. Because if only 3 or 4 are maintained, the vehicle needs more traction and the engine must be more active, make the machine hot faster, consume fuel.

3. Check weight



Most motorcycles, according to the manufacturer's instructions, should only carry 2 people, so we should not force the car to carry more than the number of people or the number of goods required to make the vehicle engine under pressure. The weight of the vehicle also has a significant impact on the vehicle's fuel consumption.

4. Change your fueling habit



Many of us have a habit of filling up the gas tank and filling it up, which really harms the car as it makes the car eat more gasoline, leaks gasoline, and fire. Besides, you should pour gasoline in the morning when the temperature is still quite cool, gasoline will not evaporate too much.

In addition, we should not be cheap to choose cheap gasoline, poor quality, these poor quality gasoline will not match the compression ratio of motorbike can cause harm. bad to the van and the mechanism inside the car.

5. Always check tires



Always keep the tire in perfect pressure because if the tire is slightly airy, the tire will spread out, increasing the exposure to the road surface, which causes the engine to pull more and obviously cost more fuel.

But don't pump the tire too much as it will affect your driving experience, resulting in faster tire wear. Please note that external temperatures also affect tire pressure, fueling fuel, reducing vehicle life, so regularly check tire pressure.

Finally, if you participate in urban traffic and have to stop waiting for red lights for a long time, be sure to turn off the engine to ensure fuel savings and environmental protection.
