Risk of Rain 2 is a lively third-person roguelike game where up to 4 players travel together across various otherworldly planets, wreaking havoc and looting everything along the way. The amount of items and the synergy of the members to test 10 unique characters can be a bit overwhelming for newbies.



That's why, in this article, let's find out the tips you need to know to succeed in the adventure of Risk of Rain 2. All of this information will help ensure gamers have the best chance of survival possible. Just remember to keep moving, always keep attacking, and don't spend too much time hunting for treasure chests, or everyone will have a hard time.

## Risk of Rain 2 tips for beginners

### All items are useful

As a general rule, no item is useless in Risk of Rain 2. Any white, green, yellow and red item will add new abilities to the character or increase some stats, such as speed, respawn ability,.



However, items that are blue often come with a price to pay. For example Shaped Glass, increases base damage by 100% but reduces max health by 50%. While the items are useful, be careful when using the blue ones.

Some combinations can be deadly, if the player or teammates have Glowing Meteorite (which activates a meteor shower for 20 seconds that damages friendly characters, as well as enemies) and Gesture of the Drowned (cooldown reduction, automatically activates items after equipping), which can bring terrible chaos.

### 3D Printer is a great tool

When starting to figure out which items work best with each character, keep an eye out for 3D Printer. It provides a specific item, which is always displayed at the top. The way they work is to 'recycle' a gamer's item randomly from the same rarity.

If it sees a rare green item, it will consume a player's green item, randomly equal to the number of items the player is carrying in that category.



Since gamers can find items anywhere, it's a good idea to stop and focus on one stage aspect of your character that you want to enhance before continuing.

There are also Scrappers, which allow you to pick any of your items and discard them. The scrap can then be traded at the 3D Printer. Players lose items in the meantime, but can protect the items they want to keep and not lose them to the cruel god of the RNG.

## Don't underestimate the turret



It's always more appealing to spend money on chests than turrets, but it really helps. There are also different types of turrets, some focused on healing, others will shoot anything in sight, and the best part is that they follow the player through the levels. Whether playing solo or with friends, turrets can add solid support to a group, especially in terms of numbers.

## Sticking after a boss fight



Activating the teleporter will trigger a boss battle at all levels, and once the loot is picked up, at the end of the enemy wave, players can hang on before moving on to the next wave.

If you don't have time to search all the chests or just want to use the recently earned money from the fight, this is a great opportunity to do so. Just keep an eye on the difficulty of the game, as it will keep increasing over time.
