Saline is a mixture of saline solution and some other drugs, used for eye, nose, wound cleaning .

There is little evidence that washing your nose regularly with saline can help people with a cold recover faster, but this may not help the body fight respiratory diseases. According to WHO, there is currently no evidence that saline use can help users avoid being infected with the new corona virus.


2. Can the pneumonia vaccine prevent new corona virus?

No. Vaccines against pneumonia, such as pneumococcal vaccine and Haemophilus influenza type B (Hib) vaccine, do not provide protection against the new coronavirus.

The virus is so new and different that it needs its own vaccine. Researchers are trying to develop a vaccine against 2019-nCoV, and WHO is supporting their efforts.

Although these vaccines are not effective against 2019-nCoV, vaccination against respiratory illnesses is highly recommended to protect your health.

Do vaccines against pneumonia protect you against the new coronavirus?



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The answer is no. 2019-nCoV is a new strain of virus, different from the ones we already know, so the Haemophilus type B (Hib) flu vaccines and the pneumonia vaccine can't help us against the new Corona virus.

Currently, researchers are still trying to develop vacxxin to treat the new corona virus.


3. Is there a cure for the new corona virus?

To date, there is no specific medicine recommended to prevent or treat the new coronavirus (2019-nCoV).

However, those infected with the virus should receive appropriate care to relieve and treat symptoms, and those with severe illness should receive optimized supportive care. Some specific treatments are under investigation, and will be tested through clinical trials.

WHO is helping to accelerate research and development efforts with a range of partners.

Are there any specific medicines to prevent or treat the new coronavirus?



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There is no cure for the new corona virus, so far.


4. Can antibiotics be used to fight and treat the new corona virus?

No, antibiotics do not work against viruses, only bacteria.

The new coronavirus (2019-nCoV) is a virus and, therefore, antibiotics should not be used as a means of prevention or treatment.

However, if you are hospitalized for the 2019-nCoV, you may receive antibiotics since bacterial co-infection is possible.

Are antibiotics effective in preventing and treating the new coronavirus?

nCoV 2019 is a virus, while antibiotics treat bacteria but not viruses. Therefore, antibiotics are useless in fighting and treating new corona virus.

However, patients with a new corona virus infection may still be prescribed antibiotics to treat opportunistic bacterial diseases.

5. Who can spread corona virus, the elderly or only young people?



People of all ages can be infected by the new coronavirus (nCoV-2019). Older people, and people with pre-existing medical conditions (such as asthma, diabetes, heart disease) appear to be more vulnerable to becoming severely ill with the virus. WHO advise people of all age to take steps to protect themselves from the virus, for example by following good hand hygiene and good respiratory hygiene.

Does the new coronavirus affect older people, or are younger people also susceptible?

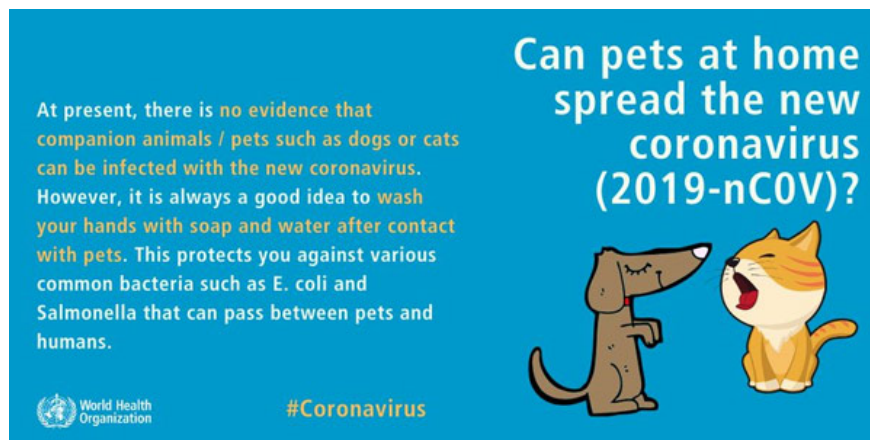
Is it safe to receive a letter or a package from China?

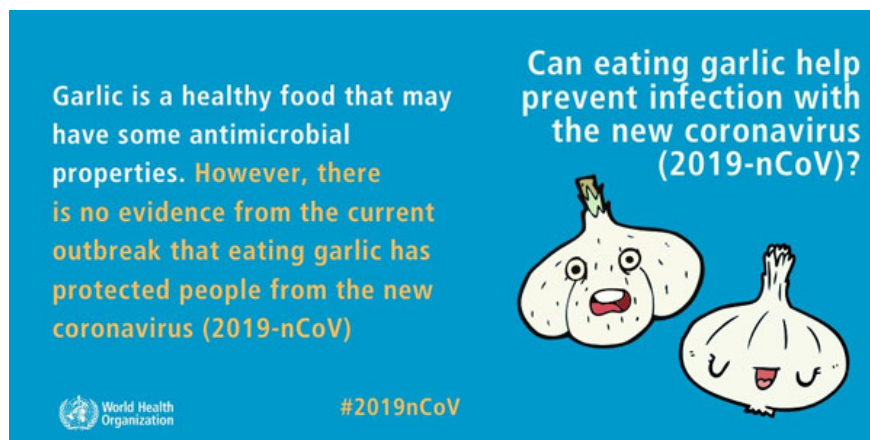
According to studies, corona virus cannot survive long on objects. Therefore, receiving packages sent from China will not be afraid of new corona virus infection.
