

Safe update for Acrobat and New Forxit Reader

Adobe has announced standards for updating Acrobat and Adobe Reader products

***TipsMake.com* - Adobe has announced the standards used in updating Acrobat and Adobe Reader products, while Foxit has added many new functions in upgrading their PDF Reader.**



Adobe's updates reflect the company's rapid improvement, since June 13 (this also means there are no new updates to date). Previous versions include: Adobe Reader and Acrobat 9.3.2 for Windows, Mac, and UNIX; Reader and Acrobat 8.2.2 are used in Windows and Mac. Also announced by Adobe, vulnerability can cause applications to fail and allow attackers to perform control on the system easily.

Both products have automatic update functionality, so you should update them immediately when running them. Security information will give you a direct link to download updates.

Meanwhile, one of Adobe's competitors has released a new Reader version. Foxit Reader 4.0 (Windows only) has all the PDF functions from open, to print highlighted pages and links. The new version adds a tool that

allows you to add text to any page. It also provides tools for drawing, editing, commenting and marking tools.

The Foxit Reader is free. The company also offers PDF-related products including PDF Editor (\$ 99) and Foxit Phantom (\$ 129), and all PDF manipulation tools.
