

## Samsung in turn swirled Apple's iPhone

Shortly after Apple introduced the iPhone 6 and iPhone 6 Plus duo, Samsung Philippines' official Twitter page posted a tweet that parodied Apple's statement that it increased the screen size for iPhone 6.

After Sony and HTC, Samsung in turn also voiced "swirling" the Apple iPhone 6.
