To exit Repair Mode, you need to restart the device and authenticate via fingerprint or parten recognition.

According to Samsung's announcement, Repair Mode will be updated soon for the Galaxy S21 series in Korea. In the next time, it will be put on other Galaxy smartphone models and be expanded to many other markets.

If Samsung pioneers and succeeds with Repair Mode, other smartphone brands will certainly follow in order to provide a safer experience for users.
