

Samsung laptop, LG competes to burn battery

On February 21, the battery of a laptop manufactured by LG Electronics is being used on the hand of a student who suddenly fuses. No information about the damage occurred.

Jik Soo Kim - LG Electronics spokesman - said immediately after the incident the company had issued a notice to stop selling the faulty laptop line and start the investigation process to find the cause of the problem.



Besides, LG spokesman also said that the phenomenon of molten battery is also an inherent safety feature of the product. Accordingly, the battery will automatically melt in case of a risk of explosion.

Three days later - February 24 - Samsung's laptop battery is melting.

A Samsung official said after more than three hours of continuous operation, the battery of the laptop said it had melted and melted. Thankfully, there was no explosion. The damage of the incident is only black burns on the bed and the owner 's floor.

The manufacturer said the problem is the Samsung P10. This product has been produced since 2002. Samsung declined to reveal the identity of the battery manufacturer.

Currently the company is conducting a detailed investigation to clarify the cause of the incident.
