However, unlike every time, this year's Galaxy S20 + 5G Olympic will not only be given to athletes who take the exam, but will be officially sold by Samsung to the market so that every user can own the session. Special edition celebrating this 2020 Olympic Games.



Galaxy S20 + 5G Olympic Edition

The Olympic version of the Galaxy S20 + 5G will have 12GB of RAM, come with 128GB ROM and run on Snapdragon 865 chip, other parameters of the screen, camera or battery life will be kept the same as the standard version. The price that Samsung offers for this special version will be 114,840 Yen, equivalent to about 1050 USD (nearly 25 million VND), this price is only a few hundred thousand more expensive than the standard S20 + version.

Samsung has also allowed users to pre-order the Olympic-sized Galaxy S20 + 5G on Docomo's official website. However, due to the complicated situation and the impact of the Covid-19 epidemic, the first shipment will

begin in June, which means that users will have to wait for nearly 3 months to get the version. this.
