

Scary hair with the scary carnivorous tribes in the world

Cannibalism is an extremely frightening act but in human history has appeared these tragic hobby tribes.

Here are the scariest cannibal tribes in the world.

The people eat the brains of people in funerals

Fore tribes live separately from the outside world in Eastern Papua New Guinea. They continue to eat people in the funeral, as a way of paying respect to the dead. Men who eat skin, women and children eat the brain of the dead.

This barbaric practice is what causes Fore people to lose 2% of the population each year. The degenerate molecules in the dead brain spread throughout the female body in the tribe causing a pandemic of kuru, a similar disease like mad cow, Alzheimer's disease or Parkinson's disease.

Korowai cannibalism

Korowai people are a cannibal tribe living in forests in Papua Province, Southeast Indonesia. This tribe has a way of living almost as primitive, living only on tall trees, separate from the outside world.

Korowai tribe is considered to be the only remaining cannibal tribe in the world to this day. They used to have headhunting and cannibalism. Korowai people have immortal beliefs with demons, the occupation of souls and death so they are extremely afraid of witchcraft.

Their victims are often enemies of neighboring tribes captured after battles or the Korowai tribes themselves when suspected of being witches. After eating meat, Korowai people used the victims' skulls to make indoor decorations.

Today, being exposed to modern civilization, Korowai people no longer hold the habit of scary human eating, but the skeletons of the dark ruins of Papua New Guinea in the past still have descendants in tribe kept.

Native Australian tribes

In Australia, the predominantly predatory tribes live on islands in the southern coast of the continent. For each tribe, the custom of eating human flesh has its own meaning.

For those in the Kurna tribe, living in the Adelaide area, cannibalism will help "the heart grow from inside". Kurna people have "traditional" cannibalism when entering drought summer.

But with the Ngarigo tribe, eating predators is regarded as exposing victories as well as disregard for enemies.

Leopart jaguar organization

Leopart jaguar began secretly in the mid-20th century, concentrating mainly in Ivory Coast, Liberi, Sierra Leone and Nigeria. According to the beliefs of this organization, eating raw human flesh will help them improve their health.

The members of the organization often wear jaguar-like costumes along with sharp claws that are always ready to ambush their prey. The spoils will be cut into small pieces of meat and divided among tribal members, including women.

The Aghori monks in exile in Varanasi, India hold a rite of cannibalism and live near a burial site in search of spiritual enlightenment. They use human skulls to make drinking glasses, chew on live animals, sleep

on human bones and meditate near corpses to seek enlightenment.

Aghori monks are men who live alone in Indian cremation zones, eating what others throw away.



In India there are bodies that are not cremated but dropped into the Ganges. The Aghori picked up those corpses to perform rituals and believed that the power came from the dead.

The Yali tribe specializes in eating predators

The wild Yali live in the Puncak Trikora mountain range, Indonesia's second highest mountain range, with a height of 4,730m.

According to legend, the ancestors of the Yali people today are the Papuan Yalis people who not only eat meat but also crush the bones of the enemies scattered throughout the valley, which terrifies other tribes.

In the 1970s, Chief Roni of the Yali tribe used to eat the feet of his enemies, causing the other tribes to be terrified whenever they mentioned his name.

Right now, the Yali people have given up the custom of predation, but the old cannibal stories are still handed down.

Bagesu tribe with horrifying funeral in the night

The Bagesu tribe is known for the horrifying funeral that usually takes place at night. When a person dies, the corpse will be kept indoors and relatives gather to celebrate the funeral in the evening.

When the sunset falls, the body is taken to a wasteland. The men lurked in the darkness and used the horns to make sounds like the sound of a bitch. At night, the elderly women with relatives of the dead came to the body, cut a piece of meat they wanted and took it home, the rest was for wild animals. After the ceremony is over, the widows will burn grass and nude dresses, or wear a small loincloth like unmarried girls.
