Notre Dame University is ranked one of the leading universities and research institutes in the United States.

## **6. Queen's University Belfast, Northern Ireland**

Queen's Belfast University was founded in 1845 by Queen Victoria and is the ninth-oldest university of the United Kingdom. The school has more than 300 buildings with a total of over 25,000 students, including many Nobel laureates and alumni. Queen's Belfast University is currently a member of Russell Group - Group of 20 most prestigious universities in the UK for research, from areas such as cancer research, sustainable development, to wireless technology and medicine.

The front of the school is the Lanyon building, built in 1849 in the Tudor Gothic architectural style with a red brick color that feels warm and welcoming. The school's dormitory is located just outside the south of Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland. Traveling from Northern Ireland to other British cities is also easy, taking only about 1 hour flight from Belfast's airports. 40 minutes from London by air.

## **7. Moscow National University, Russia**

Although newly founded not long ago, Moscow University has become a feature of the city. The main building of the 36-storey high school stands out prominently, illuminating the transparent mirror-like lake on the opposite side, creating a beautiful setting.

## **8. University of Glasgow, Scotland**

Founded in 1451, Glasgow University was named the oldest beautiful university in Scotland. The central building of the school is built in Gothic style, inspired by the famous Westminster palace in England. The Glasgow University Institute is one of the most prestigious research and training institutions in the UK, as well as around the world ( *ranked 73st by the Times rankings in 2008, ranked 24th in Europe and 11 in the Kingdom. English* ). In 2007, the Glasgow University Institute was voted Scotland's best university of the year.

At its inception, the main campus is located at High Street, downtown Glasgow. By 1870, the school moved to Gilmorehill, located west of Glasgow, to become the school's main campus, concentrating many lecture halls and design buildings for research and learning alongside the Kelvin River.

### 12. Flagler College, Florida, USA

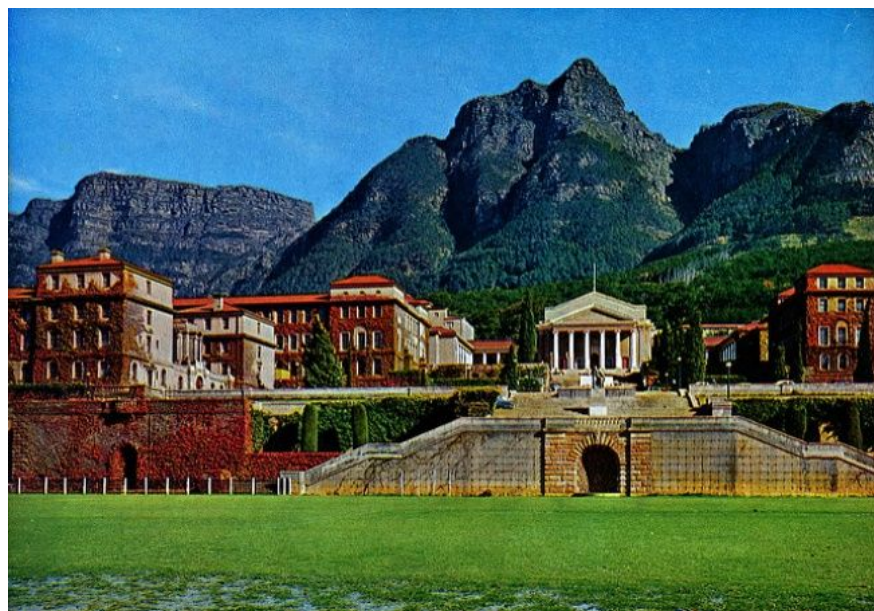


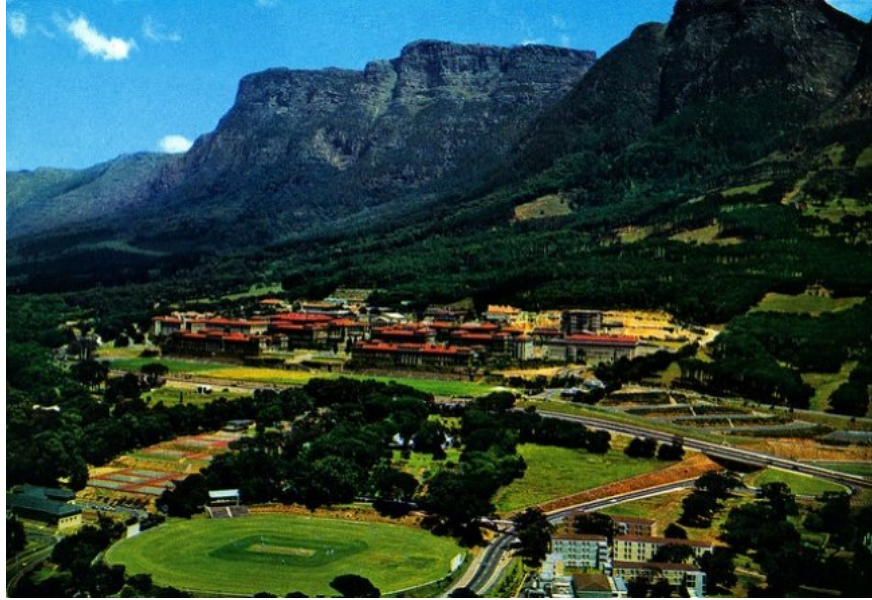
