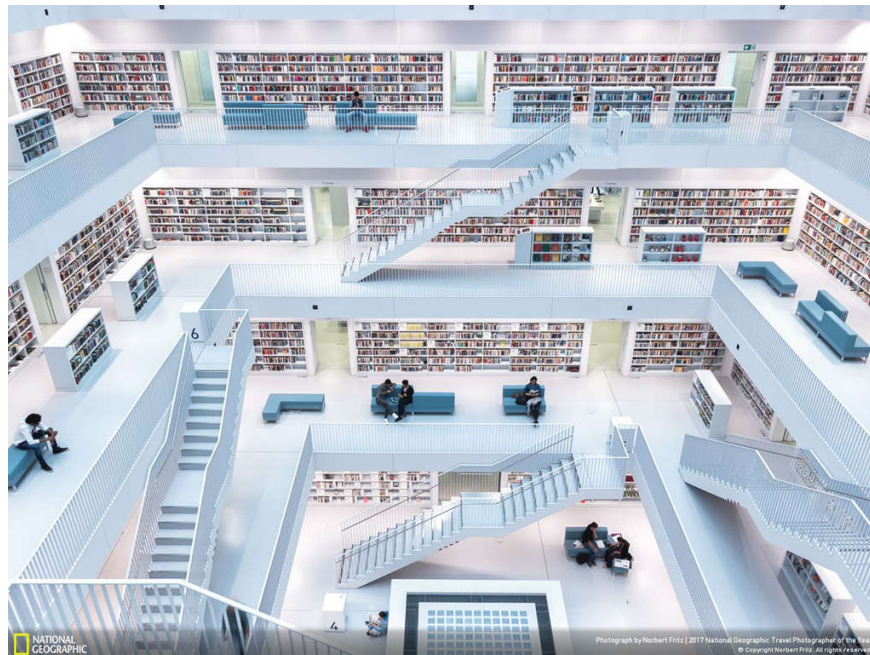

Andrzej Bochenski's 'new city in the desert' was taken at Muhafazat al-Buraimi in Oman. Viewers are not surprised by the neat construction here.

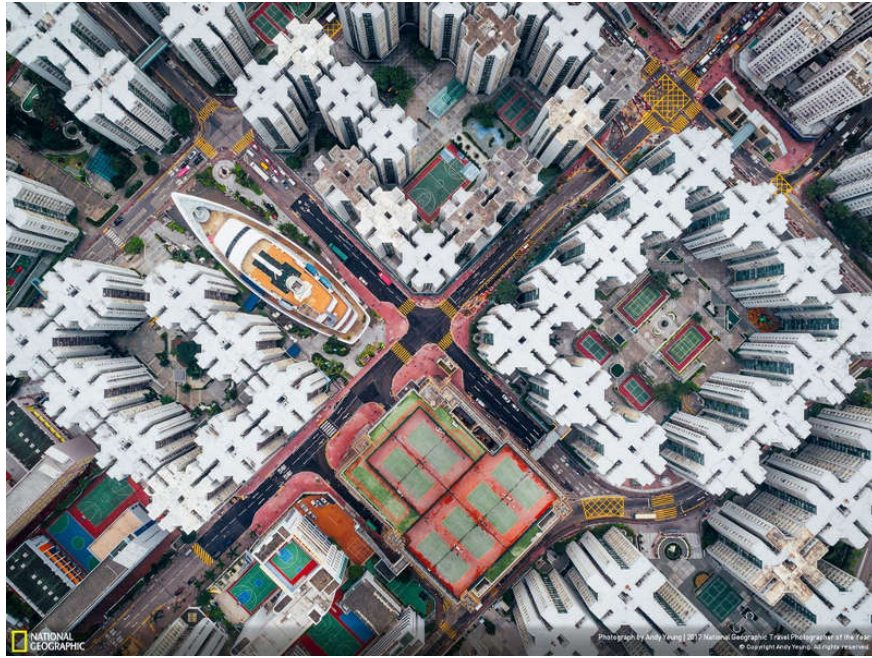
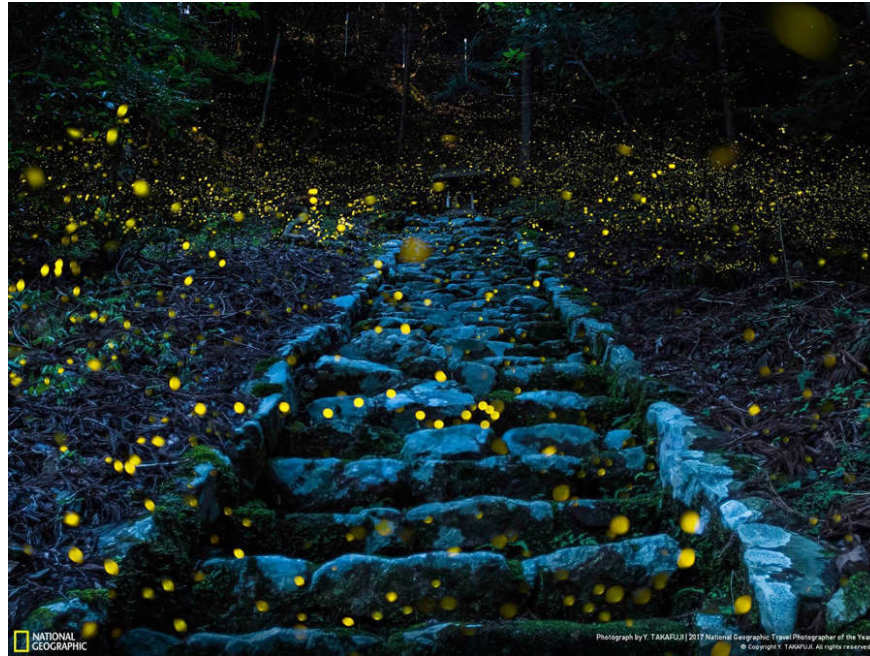


Photo of 'City Walls' taken at Kowloon Camp City, Hong Kong (China) by author Andy Yeung won second prize in Urban category.



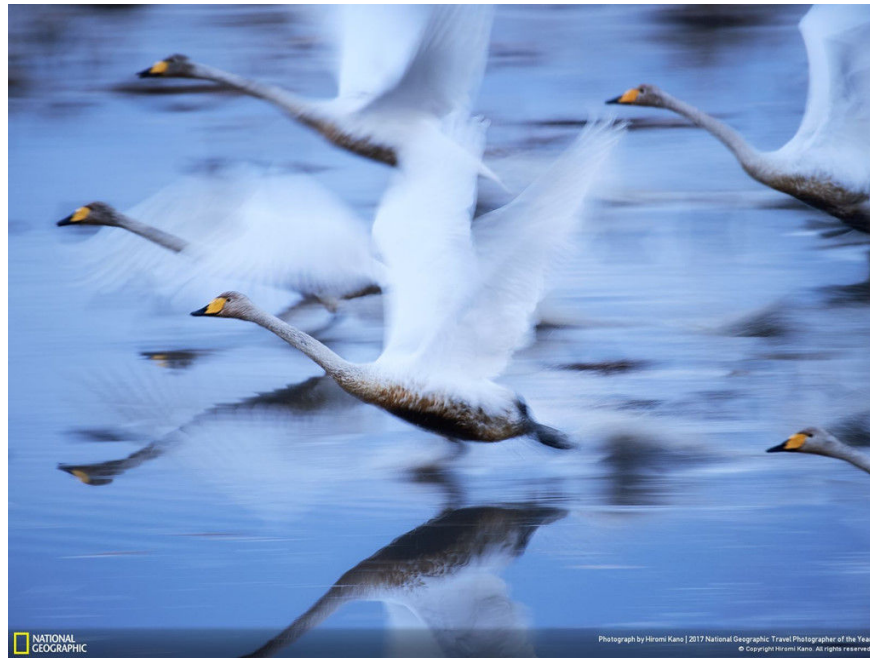
Photo of Moin Ahmed's 'Man on the Train' taken at Tongi Railway Station in Gazipur, Bangladesh received an award in the category of People.
