In a statement at the trial, prosecutors said the chips Kiet Ahn Mai had received were illegally sent to a Chinese company, and the company was run by Yi-Chi Shih in his position. chairman. Shih pays for this plan through a US-based bank account and is funded through another Chinese-based company.

According to authorities, the stolen chips in the incident were used in missile navigation systems, fighter jets, electronic combat systems, electronic warfare suppression systems and radar application. Therefore, they are extremely important meaning in military - security issues.
