

Set a password for your USB drive, create a password to protect your USB drive using USB Security.

USB Security software helps you create a password to protect your data on your USB drive, preventing others from viewing it without the password.

Most users consider setting a password on their USB drive to absolutely protect the data stored on it, preventing others from accessing it. Security tools like USB Lock are very suitable for protecting your USB drive. This article from TipsMake will guide you on how to set a password to protect your USB drive using USB Security.

USB Set Password

How to password protect your USB drive using USB Security:

Step 1 : Download and install the software. You can download the latest version of **USB Security**.

Step 2 : Plug the USB drive into your computer and then install the USB Security software.

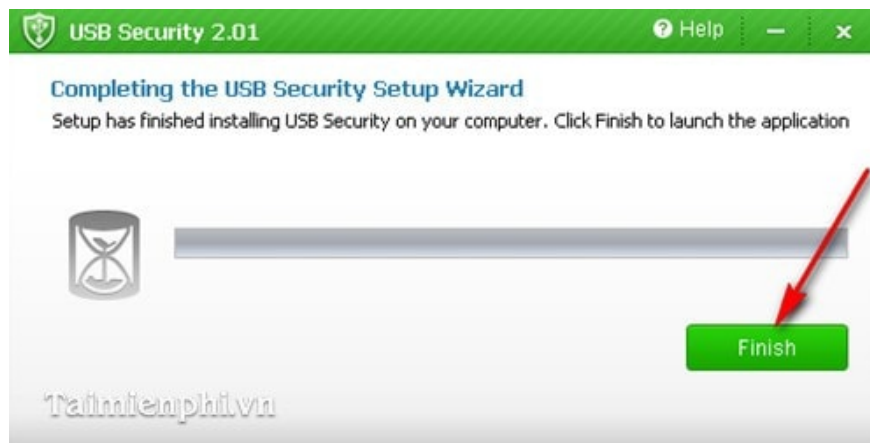
Click on **Accept** and you will see the following window appear.



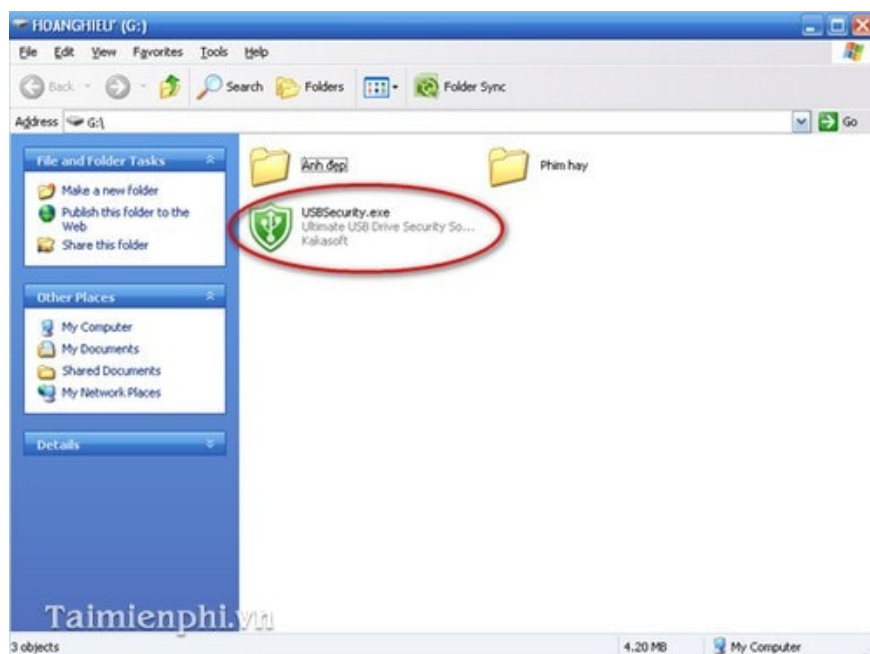
Step 3 : The program will display the name of the USB drive - in this case, drive **G: (Portable Drive)** . Click on it and then click **Install** to continue the installation.



- The installation process is complete. Click **Finish** .



- The USB drive window will automatically appear. Inside, you will find the file **USBSecurity.exe**



Step 4 : Set a password : Click on the **USBSecurity.exe** file ; the software interface will appear, allowing you to set a password.



- Set a password for the USB drive:

At step 1 – Enter password.

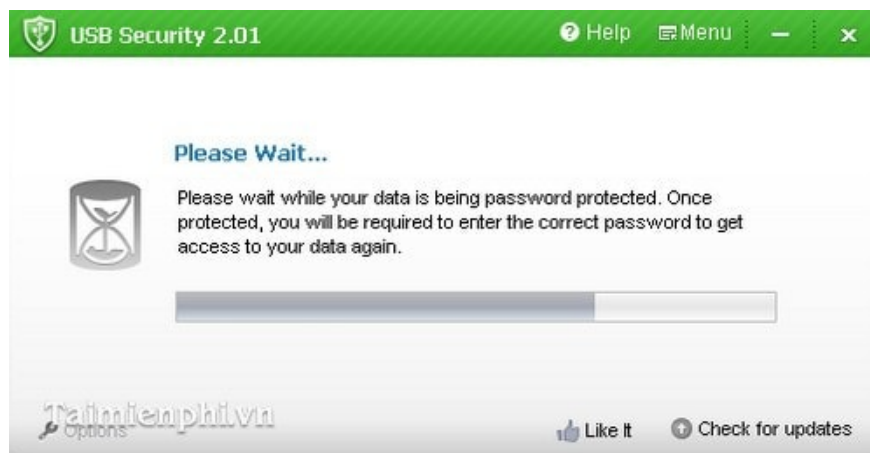
At step 2 – Re-enter password number 1.

At step 3 – Password hint, enter numbers or letters that you can easily remember (this is in case you forget password number 1).

Next, press **Protect** to set the USB password.

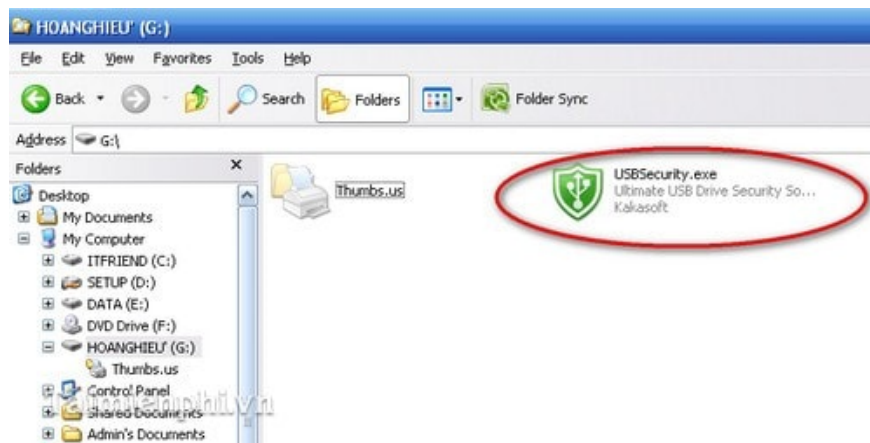


- The process of setting up a password to protect your data.



When you open the USB drive, you won't see the previous files anymore, only a single file named **USBSecurity.exe**.

However, you can still view the USB's parameters such as **its name and capacity**.



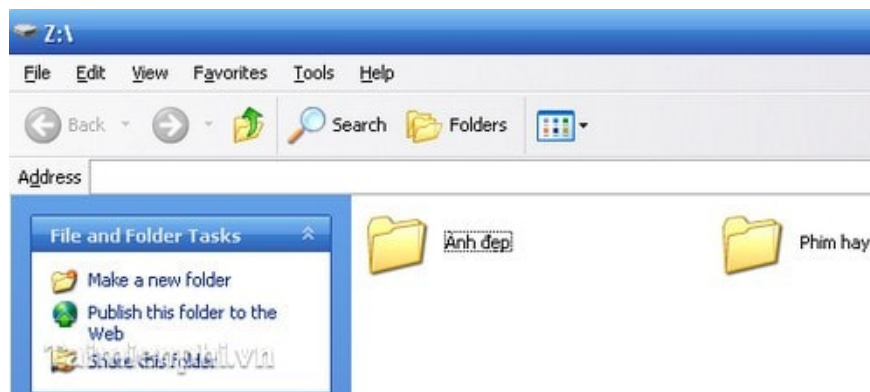
Viewing data on a USB drive after setting a password:

Step 1 : Open the USB drive, then click on the **USBSecurity.exe**

file . The USBSecurity program will appear. In the **Password** field , enter the password you created earlier. Then click **Open in virtual drive**.



Step 2 : All data on the USB drive will appear normally.



To remove the password from a USB drive

: Open the USB drive, then click on the **USBSecurity.exe** file . Enter your password and then click "Unprotect this drive".



By setting a password for your USB drive using USB Security, you no longer have to worry about your data being exposed or accessed illegally. Additionally, you can refer to and use the USB WriteProtector trick to prevent others from copying your data.

Additionally, if you're using a Wi-Fi modem, you should also regularly change your Wi-Fi password to prevent unauthorized access, which can limit the quality of your Wi-Fi signal. The method for changing your Wi-Fi password will vary depending on your modem.

One effective way to protect your Windows 10 computer is to create a USB security key. With this method, you can only unlock your computer when you have the created USB drive. Refer to the instructions on how to **create a USB security key on Windows 10** for more details.
