**Step 1:** First you need to download **Folder Lock** and install on your computer.

After installing you open the program up.

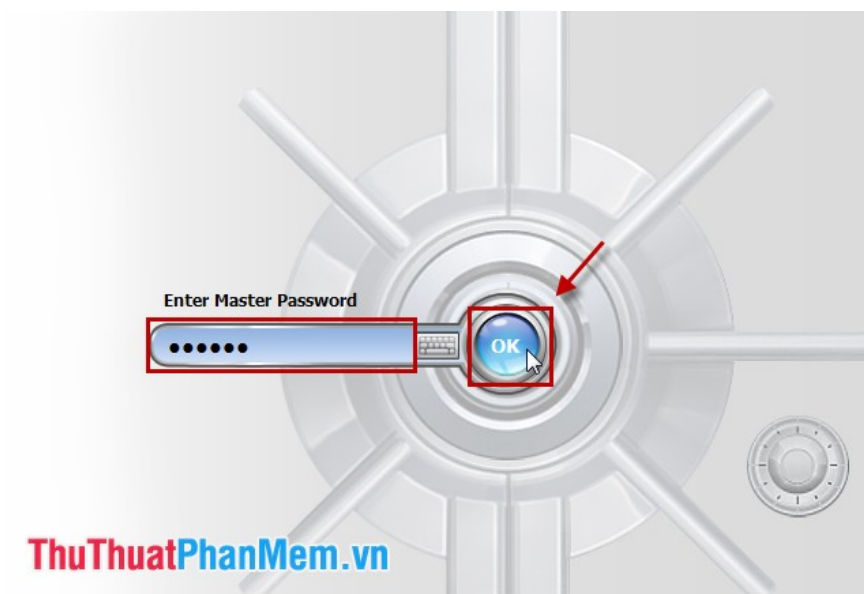


**Step 2:** The program requires you to enter the main password.

*Note:* You need to choose a password carefully, because if you forget the password, the program will not retrieve the password.

Thus the folder has been installed by the password program will not open.

You select the password and enter the password into the **Enter Master Password** then select **OK**.



After selecting **OK**, you will go to the management of **Folder Lock**.



**Step 3:** Add the folder to install the password.

You can add folders to be secured to **Folder Lock** by clicking **Add** and selecting **Add Folder** .



Select the folder to be secured, you can select multiple folders and those folders will be displayed at the program.

You can delete a folder no longer need security by selecting the folder and selecting **Remove** .

So you've set the password for the folders you want to protect. **Folder Lock** will manage the locked folders.

1. To remove the password for the directory you do the following:
2. Open the program.
3. Enter the master password.
4. Select the folder to remove the password.
5. Select Unlock.

So from now on you do not need to worry about protecting important folders because **Folder Lock** helps you keep those folders secure. Good luck!
