

Shadow, the service that allows Windows 10 to be used on any device

Shadow service will allow you to access to a powerful Windows 10 computer. This computer is configured with the latest generation Intel CPU and NVIDIA 1080 graphics card, located on a server farm.

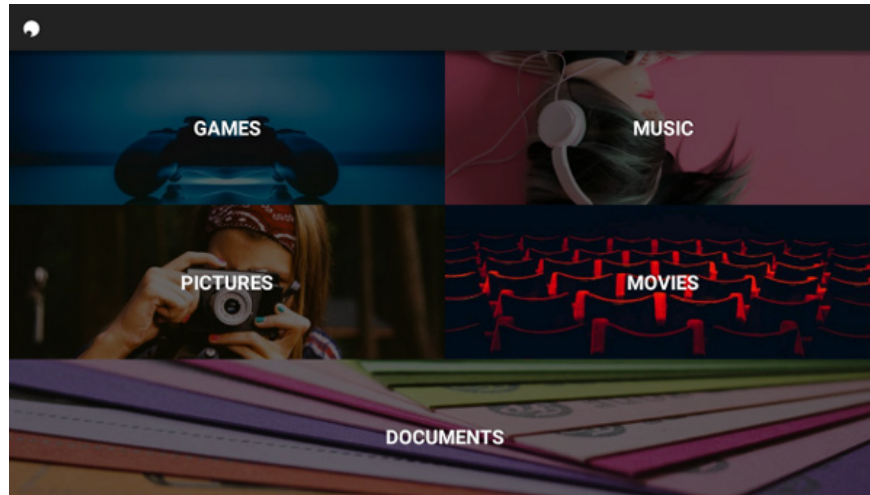
This service was introduced by Blade France at CES 2018 in January this year. Specifically, with a monthly fee, Shadow service will allow you to access to a computer running Windows 10 extremely strong. This computer has a terrible configuration with the latest generation Intel CPU and NVIDIA 1080 graphics card, placed at a "server farm". To use it, you only need to have a stable Internet connection and one of the iOS, Android, Windows, or Mac devices is okay.

At the time of introduction, Shadow was only offered in France and California. But now, Blade has decided to expand this service worldwide and the first country is America. Minimum bandwidth to use this service is only 5Mbps!



If this information is correct, future gaming will encapsulate the stream of content from a powerful PC located somewhere on Earth to a user's personal computer, tablet, and phone.

With Shadow service, users can not only play games but also can use other applications such as Blender or Premiere . At that time, users only need to spend 500 USD to buy a cheap, normal and closed computer. An additional fee of about 35 USD / month was able to get a 'terrible' machine. Clearly, it is far more economical than spending about \$ 1,500 (equivalent to a \$ 500 and 29-month Shadow service) to buy a PC similar to the one Shadow provides. .

Blade claims that with only 5 Mbps bandwidth, Shadow can bring a 720p, 60fps stream experience. To cope with unstable bandwidth speeds in the US, the company has developed an AI that can judge your network speed changes in the next few minutes. In addition, to make it easier for iOS and Android users to use Windows 10, the company has created a new application called Shadow Beyond.

Some people who used this service said that, despite having some minor problems, they could continue playing the latest Ghost Recon game on a Wifi-connected MacBook Pro after stopping playing on mobile with the link LTE connection.

From August 9, Shadow will appear on the US East Coast and will expand throughout the United States in October.
