

Share Dropbox files via Facebook Messenger

Instructions for sharing Dropbox files via Facebook Messenger

To experience this feature, your phone must install the latest version of Facebook Messenger and Dropbox.

Step 1:

Open the Facebook Messenger application in your phone. Click on anyone you want to share the file with.

At the Facebook Messenger chat window, click **the 3 framed icon** at the bottom of the screen. You will see the list of applications. Scroll down to find **Dropbox** and click **Open** .

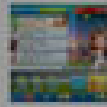

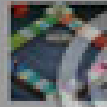


Step 3:

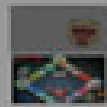

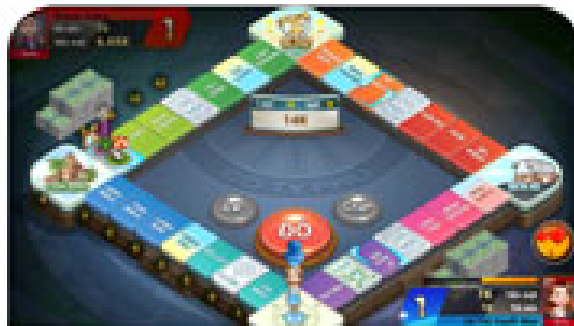

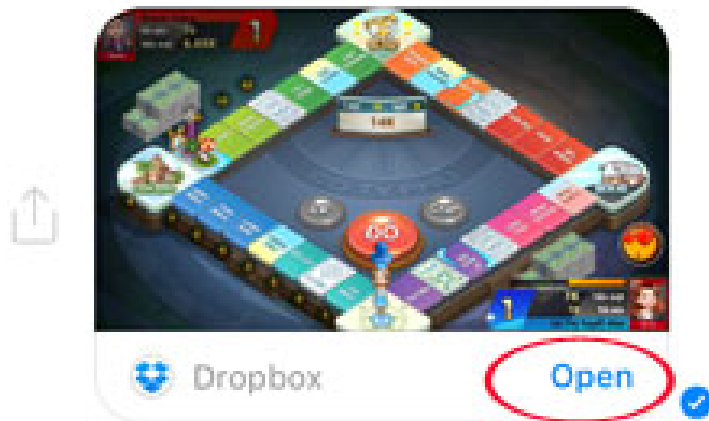
