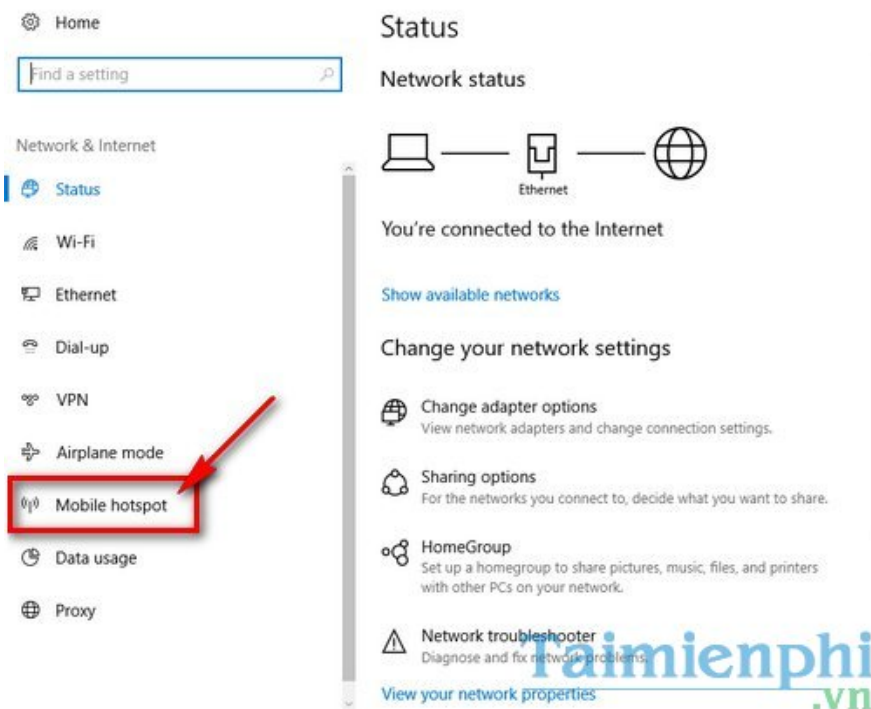
GUIDE TO SETTING UP A WIFI HOTSPOT ON WINDOWS 10 WITHOUT USING SOFTWARE

Step 1: Press the **Windows + I** key combination to open the Windows Settings window.

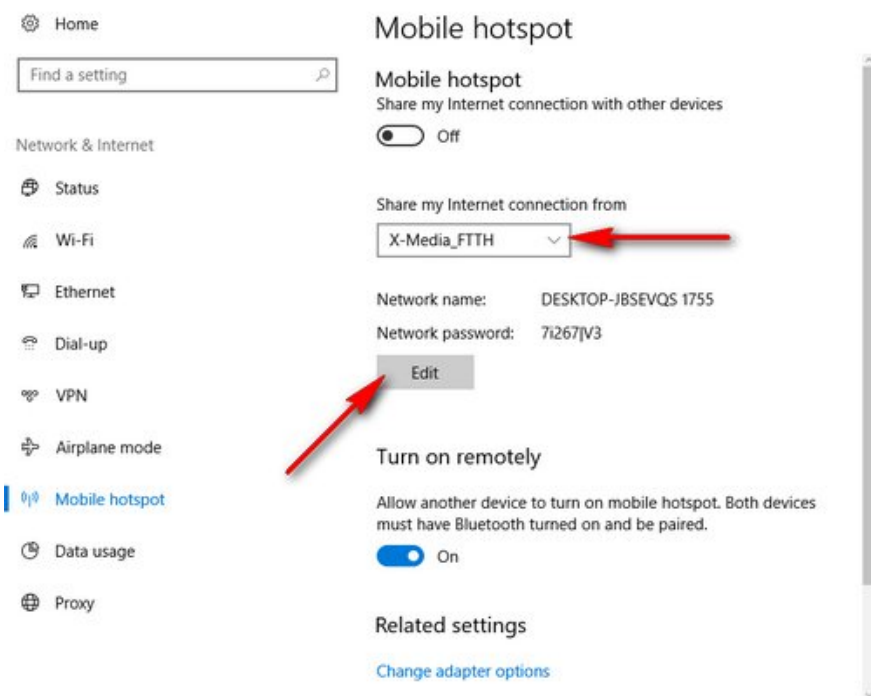
Step 2: In the **Windows Settings** window, select **Network & Internet**.



Step 3: In the left pane, scroll down and select **Mobile hotspot**.



Step 4: In the Mobile hotspot section, select the internet network you are connected to from the "**Share my internet connection from**" dropdown menu to use as the primary connection. The Wi-Fi signal your computer broadcasts will connect to this network. After selecting, click **Edit** at the bottom to set up security information for Wi-Fi broadcasting on Windows 10 without using any software.

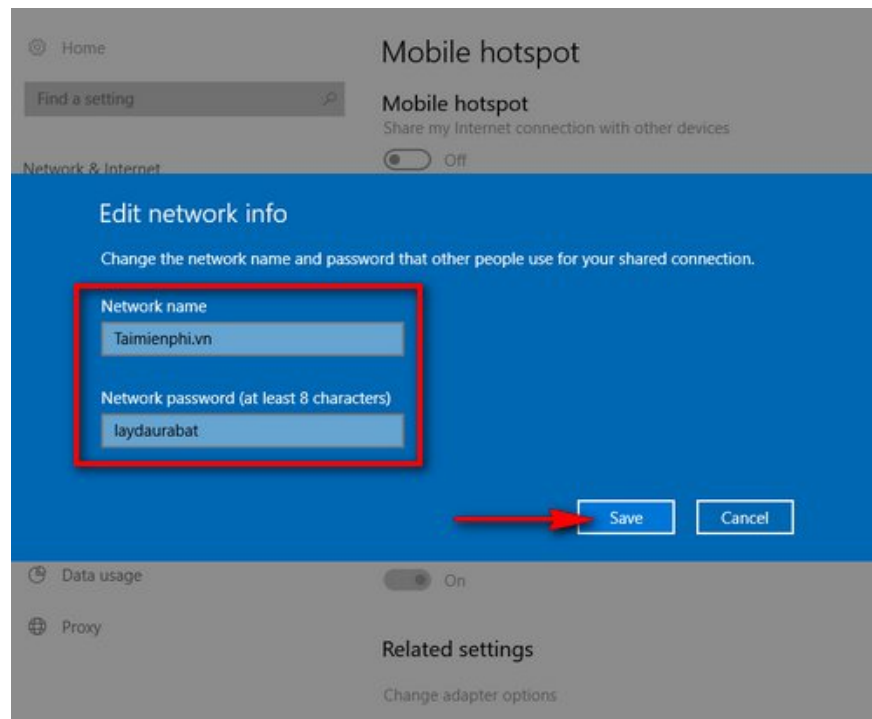


Step 5: The **Edit network info** window appears. There are two information fields:

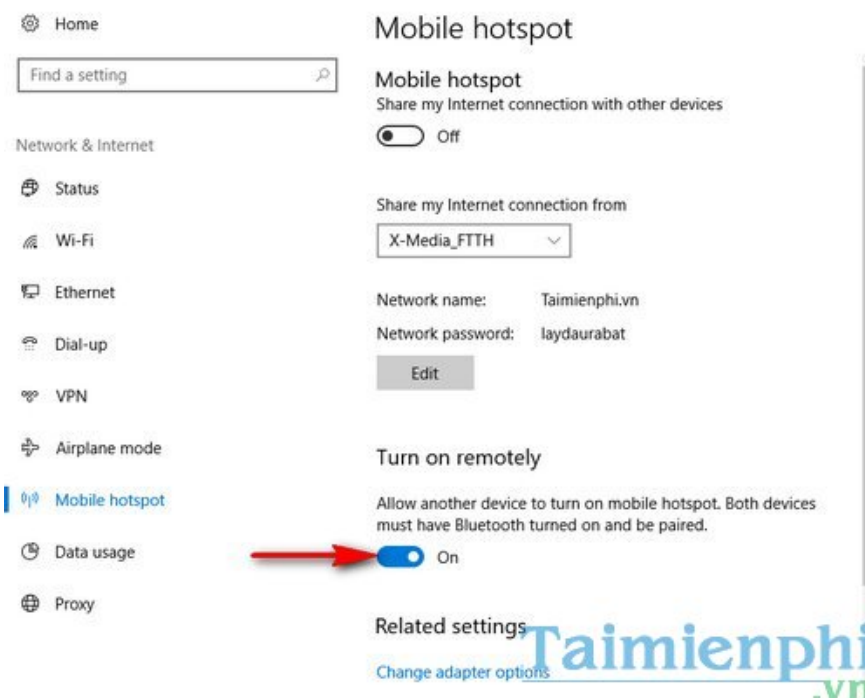
Network name : Enter the display name for the Wi-Fi network you will be broadcasting.

Network password (at least 8 characters) : Wifi network security password (minimum 8 characters)

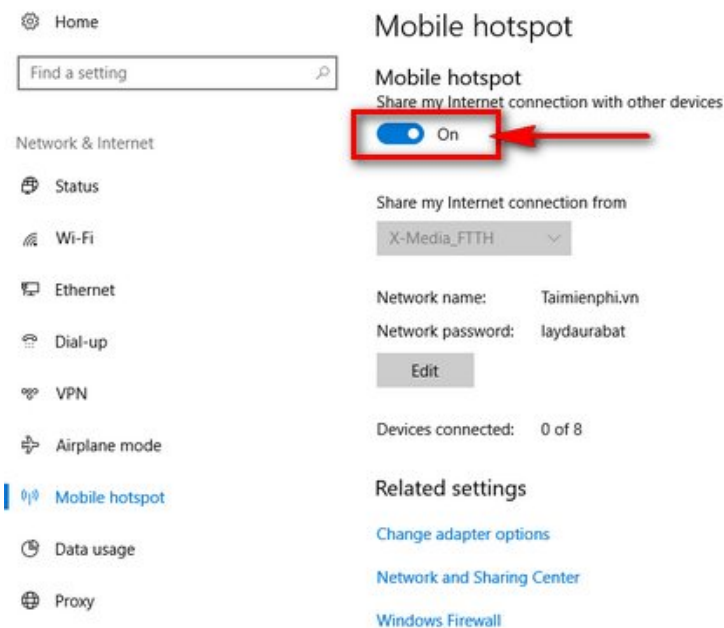
You must fill in the Network name; you can leave the Network password field blank if you don't want to set a password for your Wi-Fi network. Press **Save** to save the settings.



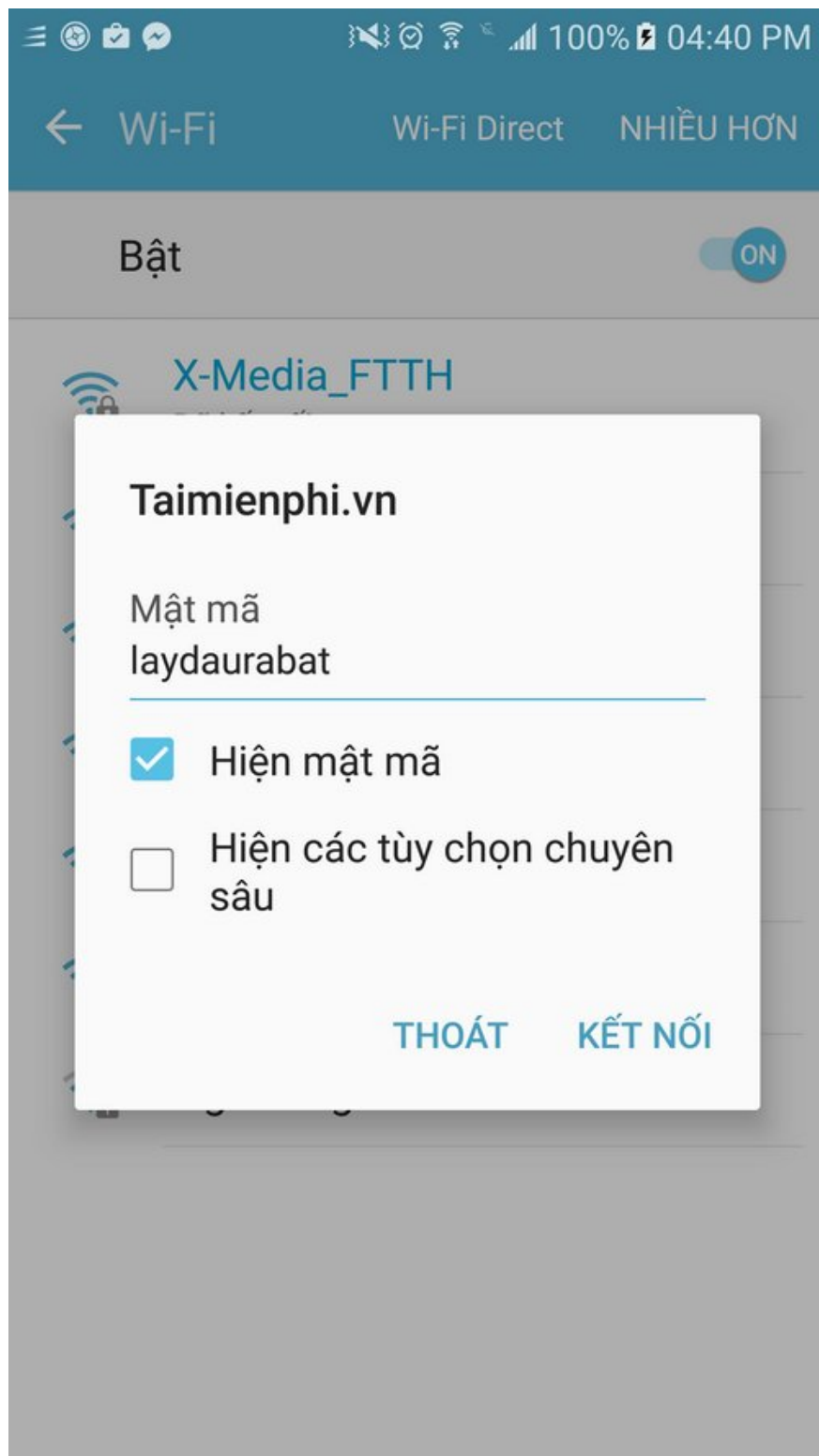
Step 6: In the "**Turn on remotely**" section , you can press "**On**" if you want to allow other devices connected to your Wi-Fi network to receive your Wi-Fi signal via Bluetooth.



Step 7: In the **Mobile hotspot** section at the top, switch the toggle to **On** to start broadcasting Wi-Fi on Windows 10 without using any software.



When you broadcast Wi-Fi from your computer, any device such as a computer or phone with Wi-Fi detection capabilities can find and connect to your Wi-Fi network.
