1. Spreepark Park, Berlin, Germany

The Spreepark theme park was opened in 1969, invested by owner *Kulturpark Plänterwald* . It used to be a favorite tourist destination for royal and bourgeois families in Berlin, who often took their children to experience artificial landscapes such as Lima Peu Temple, Egyptian Pyramid along with gliders and Ferris train. But until 2004, Spreepark was closed due to the lack of investment to build upgrades, as well as maintaining operations.

2. Six Flags New Orleans, New Orleans, Louisiana Park



Once a park famous for the castle, the house of young colors, the clowns . existed for 5 years (from 2000-2005), the Hurricane Katrina history has swept this park one more cruel way. Since then, the park has been abandoned and no one has ever recovered, a childhood world that has been extinguished in a split second after a storm.

3. Pod City, San Zhi Park, Taiwan





This theme park features a series of colored, circular building blocks, shaped into a two-story flower, it was built in Taiwan since 1978. However, when the construction works midway, many builders died, followed by the owner who lost his investment. Since then, it has been abandoned since 1980 and left behind the unfinished works, the unfulfilled dream.

4. American Heritage Park, Fort Mills, South Carolina



Heritage is a famous Walt Disney World theme park at the time of 1980 with castles, historical heroes, legends, water parks . Operating for a while, the owner of the project Mr. Hurricane Hugo went bankrupt and was forced to leave the park, leaving a piece of land in the park to do another business project, as you can see, a part of the artificial castle is still standing.

5. Gulliver Park, Kamikushiki, Japan



In this park, the highlight is the works of character statues, scenes taken from the famous games of cherry blossoms such as Silen Hill games.

This park once experienced an impressive golden age, attracting many people to arrive. Then I don't know why, it's been abandoned since then.
