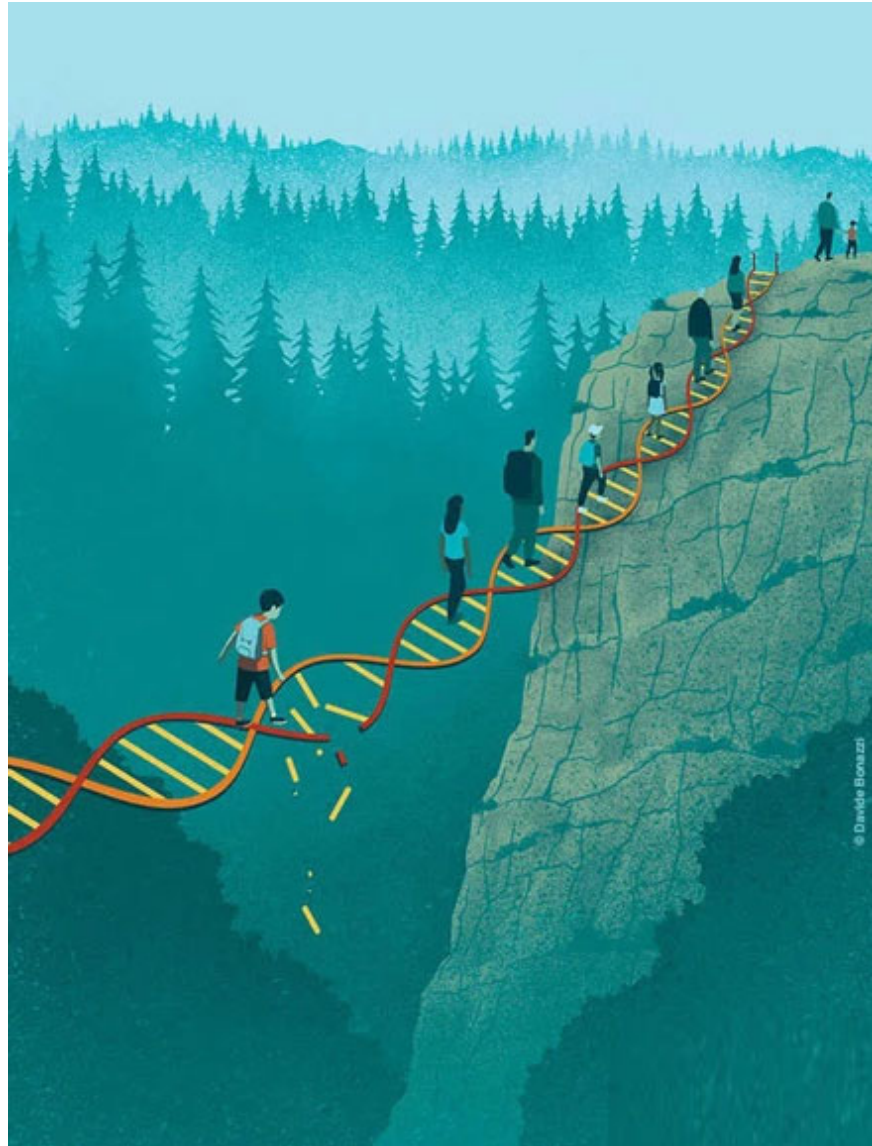
1. Meaningful short story

7. A story about seizing opportunities

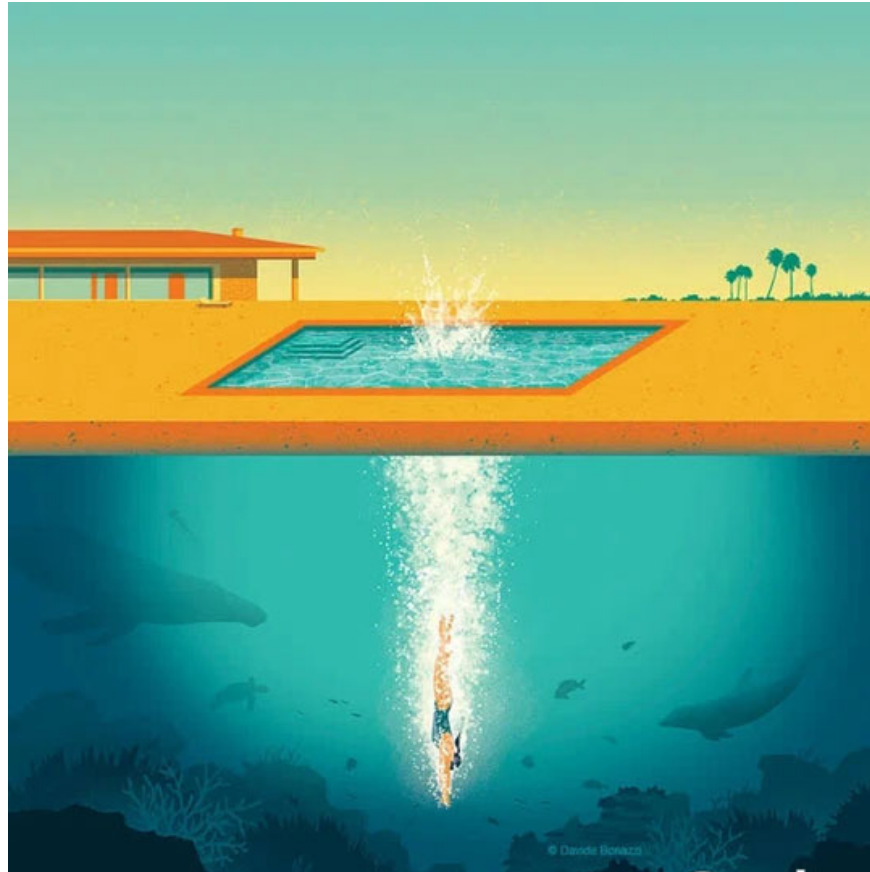
That year, while he was sitting in a coffee shop waiting for his friend, a girl came up and asked: "Are you the person that Aunt Huong introduced to come on a blind date?"
