

Should I buy a lunch box or an electric lunch box?

What is the electric lunch box different from a lunch box?

Heat preservation boxes are usually made from safe PP plastic that can be used in microwave ovens. On the other hand, the electric lunch box will need to be plugged in for about 10-20 minutes to heat up the food. The rice warming principle of these two product lines is completely different so you need to pay attention to choose the right product. If you don't have a microwave oven in your company, the only option is to buy a power lunch box.



The heat-retaining box is usually more compact than an electrical box, because there will be no electrical parts, which are responsible for heating food. This is also the reason that cleaning the plug-in lunch box needs to be more careful than washing the lunch box. Make sure the water does not penetrate the electric box of the lunch box.

Should I buy a lunch box or an electric lunch box?

Deciding whether to buy a thermos or a lunch box will depend on your needs as well as your workplace.

With a workplace with a microwave, refrigerator:

Prioritize the use of a heat preservation box, which will save you more time. Food in a lunchbox can be left in the refrigerator when you arrive at the company. After that, after dinner, bring the food to the restaurant. It only takes 2-3 minutes to make it as hot as it cooks, making sure to eat well. Food left in the refrigerator also keeps the taste better to the outside. The plug-in lunchbox will not be left in the refrigerator because it is easy to cause steam to condense into the electrical circuits and may damage the box.



With a workplace without a microwave oven:

The only option for you at this time is to use a power lunch box. The rice will still be heated but it takes longer to plug in. You will also take the initiative to not queue up for rice at the microwave.

The durability of the thermal lunch box and the power box

The heat preservation box has a simple structure, mainly made of good heat-resistant plastic material, so it is usually very durable. You can buy and use for many years with simple cleaning like regular dishes. Whereas, the plug-in lunch box needs to be skillful to avoid water in the plug-in section of the box.



The power plug box may damage the plug part during use and improper cleaning. You can replace the power cord when it detects an error in the wiring section, but if it is broken the circuit system in the box is usually not repaired. With this error, the box will only be able to function normally, cannot be used to carry rice away.
