

Should I buy the Galaxy S24 Ultra instead of the S24?

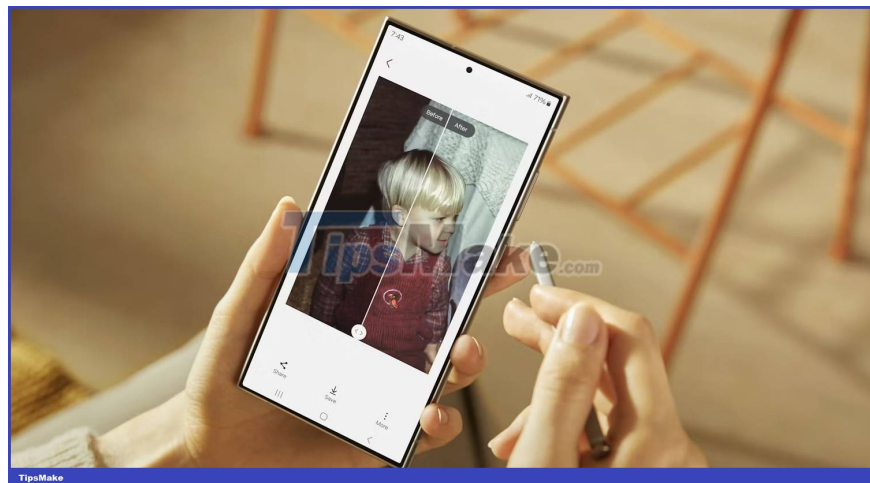
The Galaxy S24 Ultra costs \$500 more than the base-level S24 and \$300 more than the S24+, but for the extra money, what do you get in return?

The Galaxy S24 Ultra costs \$500 more than the base-level S24 and \$300 more than the S24+, but for the extra money, what do you get in return? Let's find out all the reasons why S24 Ultra is better than S24 through the following article!

1. Bigger screen with S Pen support

The main advantage of the Galaxy S24 Ultra compared to the regular S24 is the 6.8-inch QHD+ screen. This size is significantly larger than the S24's 6.2-inch FHD+ panel. Samsung claims both panels support a dynamic refresh rate of 1-120Hz and a maximum brightness of 2,600 nits, so there is no difference in panel quality other than resolution.

The S24 Ultra's screen supports the S Pen, allowing you to use a Bluetooth stylus to doodle on the screen or take quick notes. There's no way to use the S Pen on the Galaxy S24's 6.2-inch AMOLED display, and it's the same story with the S24+'s 6.7-inch QHD+ panel. If you are creative, this may be a factor to consider.



Finally, the Galaxy S24 Ultra's display uses Corning's Gorilla Glass Armor for protection, which, according to Samsung's press release, reduces reflection by up to 75% for a better viewing experience. Galaxy S24 and S24+ use old generation Gorilla Glass Victus tempered glass.

2. The internal components are stronger

In theory, the entire Galaxy S24 line uses the same "Galaxy" Snapdragon 8 Gen 3 chip. However, some internal differences make the S24 Ultra worth buying over the S24.

The Samsung Galaxy S24 Ultra has a thermal plate that is 1.9 times larger than last year's model, allowing for better heat dissipation. However, the S24 and S24+ do not receive any such improvements. Samsung has also equipped the S24 Ultra with 12GB of RAM, while the S24 only has 8GB. With Galaxy AI features, additional RAM will support multitasking.

Finally, while the Galaxy S24 is available in 128GB and 256GB storage variants, you can get the S24 Ultra with up to 1TB of storage. Additionally, the base variant of the S24 Ultra comes with 256GB storage. So, if you don't want to worry about running out of space for your data, the S24 Ultra is a better choice.

3. Premium construction quality

Samsung used a titanium frame for the Galaxy S24 Ultra to give it a more premium feel in the hand. On the Galaxy S24 (and S24+), the company used "Armor Aluminum". Titanium is stronger than aluminum and better avoids scratches in daily use. If you prefer to use your phone without a case, the S24 Ultra's titanium edges will feel much nicer.

Samsung's sustainability efforts are also better with the S24 Ultra, as it uses more recycled components than the smaller version. Samsung claims the S24 Ultra uses 40% recycled steel in the speaker and the battery uses a minimum of 50% cobalt. On the Galaxy S24, the company used recycled steel and TPU.

4. Superior camera system



If you want a phone with the best camera system, the Galaxy S24 Ultra should be your preferred choice over the S24. Samsung's Ultra flagship for 2024 has a 200MP main camera, a 12MP f/2.2 ultra-wide-angle camera, a 10MP 3x telephoto camera, and a 5x 50MP periscope camera.

The Galaxy S24 Ultra uses these lenses to provide a 3x and 5x optical zoom range as well as up to 100x digital zoom. Few phones on the market can match this level of versatility. Hopefully Samsung has also fixed shutter lag, an issue that ranks high on the list of worst things about Galaxy phones.

Galaxy S24 (and S24+) uses a 50MP main camera, 12MP ultra-wide camera and 10MP 3x telephoto camera. While smaller Galaxy phones can also take great photos, the S24 Ultra excels.

5. Better battery life

Despite having a larger 6.8-inch QHD display, you can expect the Galaxy S24 Ultra to last longer than the S24. That's because the S24 Ultra is equipped with a powerful 5,000mAh battery, compared to the S24's 4,000mAh unit.

While the S24's battery life is good enough for most people, the S24 Ultra will stand out in terms of durability. Even better, the phone can charge at speeds of up to 45W, with Samsung claiming that charging from 0 to 65% takes just 30 minutes.

The S24 is limited to 25W speeds and can charge up to 50% in 30 minutes. While you can check out some tips and tricks to charge your Android phone faster, they won't significantly reduce charging time.

Buying the Galaxy S24 Ultra instead of the S24 makes much more sense if you have the money. You get a bigger screen, better battery life, an advanced camera system, more memory, and better build quality. Basically, this phone is better than its cheaper version in every major aspect.
