When will Windows 8 and 8.1 be discontinued?

Windows 8 or 8.1 ended the main support phase on July 10, 2018. However, this is not something to worry about. Ending the main support phase only means that the operating system will not receive any new preferred features.

Windows 8.1 still has security updates, but it will also end on June 11, 2023. So unlike Windows 7, you still have plenty of time to use Windows 8.1 before Microsoft stops. support for it.

Can you still use Windows 8 or 8.1 after that?

It's correct! As of June 11, 2023, Microsoft will no longer fix any security bugs that appear on Windows 8 or 8.1. However, that is not the end of the day for Windows 8 or 8.1. These operating systems will still work fine

The question is if you can still use Windows 8 or 8.1 after it stops supporting, should you do it? No more security updates, continuing to use Windows 8 or 8.1 can be risky.

The biggest problem you'll notice is an increase in security flaws in the operating system. Because Microsoft no longer fixes security vulnerabilities, there will be a persistent hole in your defense system.

However, that does not mean that Windows 8.1 will be terminated once support expires. In fact, many users still stick with Windows 7, even though the operating system lost all support in January 2020.

By deploying a reliable antivirus program, maintaining a good firewall, and keeping it safe online, you can keep using an old operating system.

If your main concern is to use an old program that may not be compatible with Windows 10, you should know that there is a compatibility mode that allows you to run old Windows programs in Windows 10.
