Should you buy a Samsung Galaxy S21 phone?

1. Stunning design

The Samsung Galaxy S21 has made a significant leap forward in design, particularly in its rear camera module. Instead of the S20 series design or Apple's "honeycomb" camera design, the S21 features a unique rear camera module that protrudes from the top left corner of the back, giving it a seamless look and making you think it's an integral part of the S21, rather than simply an add-on like on the iPhone 11/12 series.



Next, let's talk about the premium build quality and finish of the Samsung Galaxy S21. Instead of using a completely glass or metal back like other flagship brands, the Samsung Galaxy S21 uses a frosted glass back combined with Gorilla Glass 7. This not only provides a luxurious look and impressive visual effect but also helps eliminate annoying fingerprints while maintaining durability and safety during use. The Phantom Violet color on the Samsung Galaxy S21 will surely leave a lasting impression on anyone.

2. Excellent display capabilities

Samsung has always been renowned for producing display panels that satisfy even the most demanding customers. However, the Samsung Galaxy S21 is considered to have exceeded expectations. With a maximum refresh rate of 120Hz and Full HD+ resolution, the 6.2-inch Dynamic OLED panel used in the S21 boasts the best battery efficiency on the market today.



This means you'll be able to enjoy the best display quality with the longest battery life. Brightness, color coverage, and contrast on the S21 are undeniably excellent, as it's positioned as a flagship in 2021. Furthermore, the curved bezels on the S20 series have been replaced with a flat screen, which somewhat improves the display quality on the S21.

3. Incredible battery life

As mentioned above, the new OLED panel technology of the S21 greatly optimizes battery life on this Samsung S21. While other smartphones supporting a 120Hz refresh rate can usually only last for half a day, the **4000mAh** battery on the S21 can last for a full day or even a day and a half on a single charge with a 120Hz refresh rate.



And of course, the Samsung Galaxy S21 is also equipped with QC fast charging technology up to 25W, allowing for a full battery charge in an extremely short time. Choosing a charging power of 25W, rather than a much higher power like Xiaomi or Oppo, also helps to extend the battery life of the S21.

4. The operating system can be upgraded to Android 12, 13, and 14.

Besides using the customized One UI 3.1, developed based on the latest Android operating system, the Samsung Galaxy S21 is also the second Samsung product line to benefit from a 3-year software update guarantee. This means that S21 users are guaranteed to use at least three versions **of Android (12, 13, and 14)** after purchasing the device. In contrast, the average software update lifespan for other Android products is only 2 years or less.



5. Top-tier performance

The chip used in the S21 is none other than the most powerful Android chip at the time - the Snapdragon 888. The S21 is one of the first products to be equipped with the Snapdragon 888, along with 8GB of RAM and 128/256GB of internal storage. From basic to advanced tasks such as playing demanding games, editing videos and images, the S21 handles them with ease.

6. Outstanding features

All the camera flaws that existed in the S20 series have been fixed in the S21 series. Furthermore, with its laser autofocus module, the Samsung Galaxy S21 offers significantly more accurate bokeh and focusing, eliminating the annoying focusing issues of the S20 series. Next, the addition of a depth sensor and telephoto camera allows users to utilize 3x, 10x, or even 100x zoom capabilities more effectively.

The S-Pen can now be used on the Samsung Galaxy S21. Previously, this "privilege" was only available on Samsung's Note series. This will be helpful for users, especially those who need to take many notes while traveling or working.

Ultimately, the under-display fingerprint sensor has given the S21 a very unique position in the flagship segment. While the iPhone 12 still uses FaceID, and the Xiaomi Mi 11 or Oppo FindX3 Pro still use fingerprint sensors integrated into the power button, the S21 is equipped with Qualcomm's Ultrasonic under-display fingerprint sensor, offering fast response times and high accuracy.
