The 4G version is simply called the Galaxy A32, while the 5G version is more easily identified. However, the Galaxy A32 5G version is rarely sold in mobile phone stores in Vietnam.

I. Samsung Galaxy A32 Review

1. Performance and battery

The Samsung Galaxy A32 is equipped with a MediaTek Helio G80 chip, 6 GB of RAM, and 128 GB of internal ROM (with microSD card support), significantly boosting performance and providing users with a smoother gaming and web browsing experience without lag.



Notably, the A32 also boasts a battery with a capacity of up to 5,000 mAh, enough for users to perform simple tasks for 2 days or more, or use it continuously for 14-15 hours, while also supporting 15W fast charging.

2. Camera and screen

The Samsung Galaxy A32 features a 6.4-inch Super AMOLED display with a 90Hz refresh rate, Full HD+ resolution (1080 x 2400 pixels), and a 16:9 aspect ratio, making it ideal for users who enjoy watching movies, playing games, and more on a large screen.

The familiar teardrop-shaped display design features a notch where the selfie camera is located.

In terms of cameras, the device has a quad-camera setup on the back, including a 64MP main camera, an 8MP ultra-wide-angle camera, a 5MP macro camera, and a 5MP depth sensor. The selfie camera has a resolution of 20MP.

3. Memory and Connectivity

In terms of memory, the Samsung Galaxy A32 comes with 128 GB of internal storage, with support for microSD cards to expand storage up to 1 TB.



The device runs One UI 3.0, based on Android 11, and supports various connectivity options including 4G, 5G, and other features such as Bluetooth v5.0, dual-band Wi-Fi, mobile hotspot, USB Type-C 2.0, GPS, NFC, etc. Additionally, the A32 supports two SIM cards.

4. Price of Samsung Galaxy A32

The Samsung Galaxy A32 is currently priced at **6,690,000 VND** and comes in four color options: purple, white, black, and blue.

Similar to the Samsung Galaxy A32, the upcoming Samsung Galaxy M62 also boasts impressive battery life, a striking design, a premium display, and high-quality cameras.
