

# Should you upgrade to Windows 10 version 1903?

The Windows 10 version 1903 update has officially been released. If you're wondering whether or not to upgrade to Windows 10 version 1903, continue reading this article from TipsMake to find the answer.

## *1. Should I upgrade to Windows 10 version 1903?*

Unlike previous updates, with Windows 10 version 1903, Microsoft no longer forces users to update to the new version automatically. Instead, compatible devices will receive notifications when feature updates are available, and users will have to manually install the updates through Windows Update.

This new approach by the company aims to limit and avoid problems similar to those encountered with the previous Windows 10 October 2018 Update.

Although Microsoft has implemented new measures to ensure users can upgrade and experience the new update more effectively, many people are still asking whether installing Windows 10 version 1903 is safe? Should you upgrade to Windows 10 version 1903?

The answer is **YES**. According to Microsoft, installing and upgrading to Windows 10 version 1903 is completely stable and no problems have occurred.



## ***2. Should I wait to install Windows 10 v1903?***

Typically, new versions of Windows 10 always come with a host of potential problems and bugs, and Windows 10 version 1903 is no exception.

If you're planning to upgrade to the latest version of Windows 10 even if you've received a notification that the update is ready, TipsMake recommends waiting about 3-4 days to see if any bugs or issues arise before upgrading.

Additionally, if you don't see a new option in Windows Update to download and install the Windows 10 May 2019 Update, you shouldn't use the Media Creation Tool or Update Assistant to force an upgrade to the new version.

If you attempt to upgrade to Windows 10 v1903, you will likely encounter errors and problems because the update may not be available yet, or it could be due to faulty drivers or services on your device that are incompatible with the update.
