6. Do I find it difficult to hear women's or children's voices?
7. Do I like listening to TV or radio sounds bigger than others?
8. Do I feel the ringing or buzzing in my ears?

Because there are many people with hearing impairment, it still sounds fine in quiet environments (like a doctor's office) and it can be very difficult for your doctor to recognize this problem. Only trained hearing aids can determine your hearing loss, can you benefit from hearing aids, and which ones are best for you.

While you are worried that other people find you are wearing hearing aids, they are not really aware of it. Most hearing aids are very discreet (keep in mind that hairstyles can play a big role to hide the device).
