

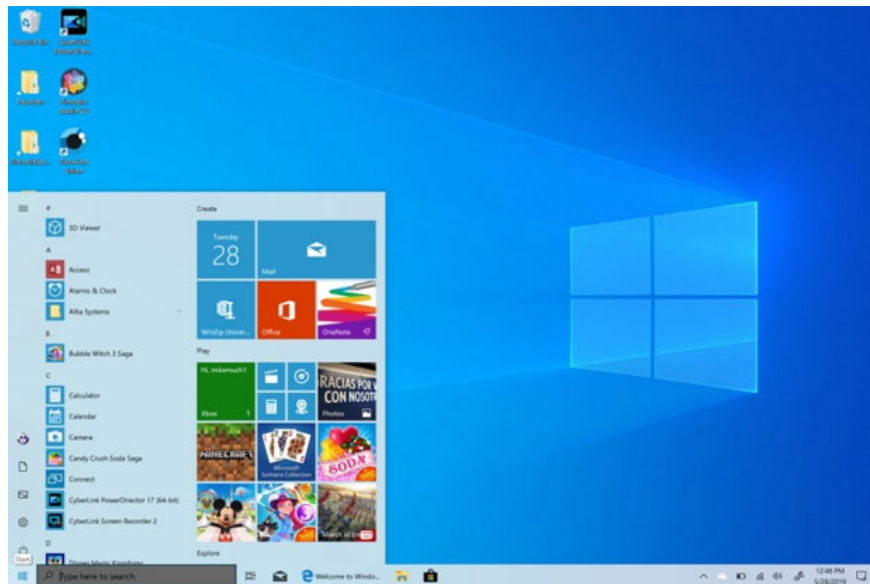
Silly errors on Windows 10 make users uncomfortable

Windows 10 has been complained about by users about countless updates, remote data collection, and design inconsistencies.

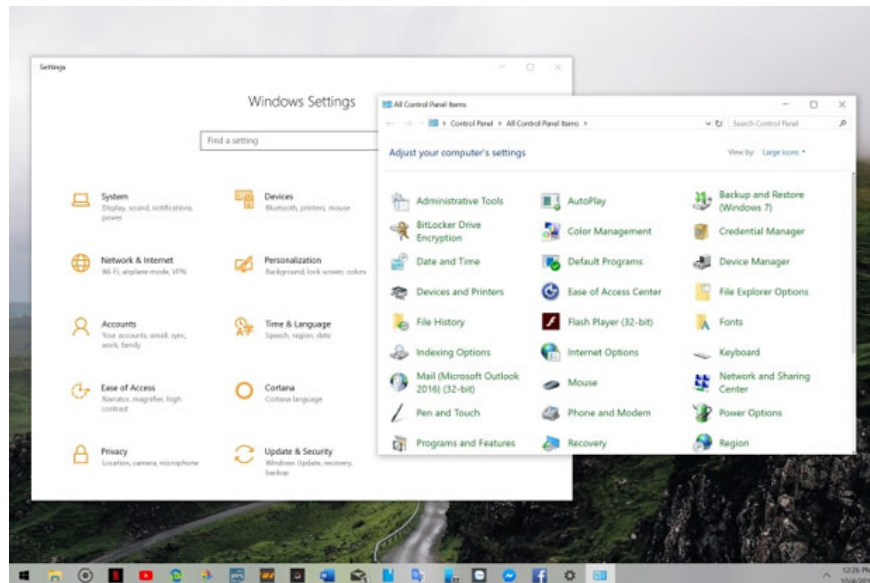

Lack of consistency in design

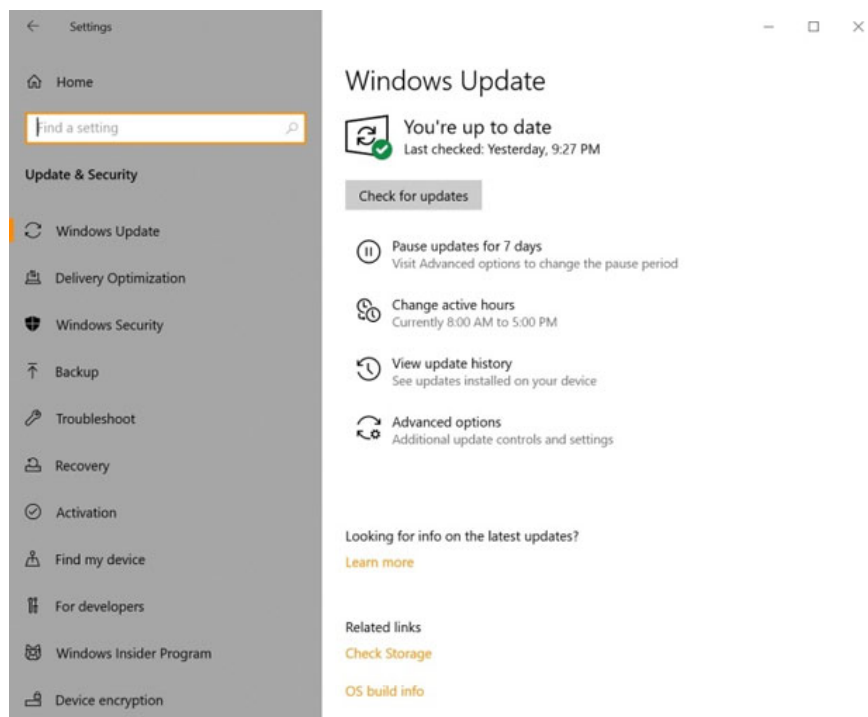
However, the combination of system functionality and design style has unintentionally caused design across the user interface to appear a series of inconsistencies. The look of modern Windows applications and classic Windows applications makes a big difference. Windows applications such as Mail, Calendar, and Photos provide a flawed feel, and contextual menus are quite cumbersome. Control Panel window with the old design language and appearance almost unchanged from the 1990s.



Although the lack of consistency in this design does not affect the work, it makes users feel that Windows 10 an operating system has no cohesion.

The update exists a series of errors

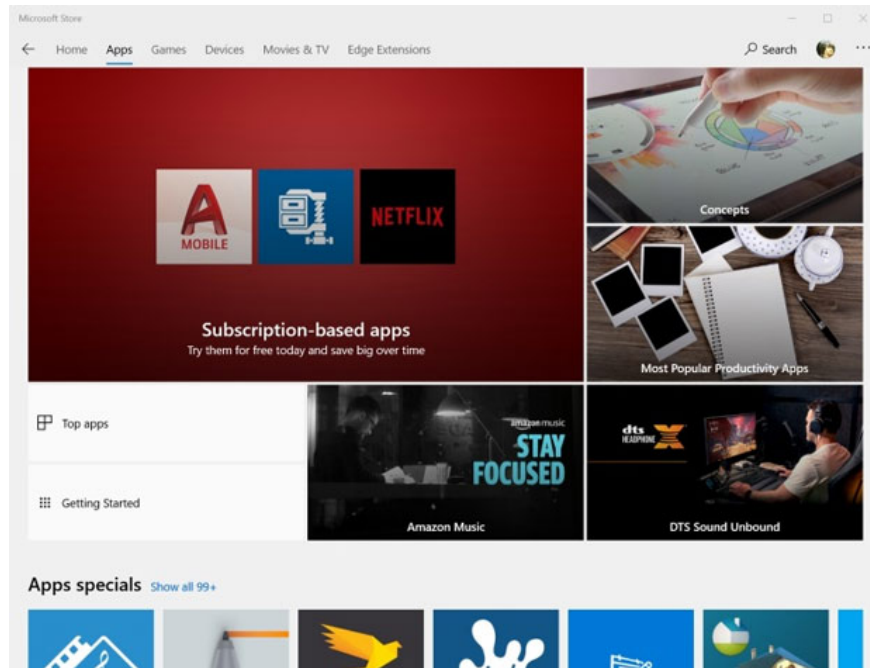
Windows 10 updates make users extremely annoyed by the appearance of a series of errors. Such as causing the PC to restart without the user even knowing it, deleting the user's file .



The released updates do not do exactly what they expected, there are even many errors that are then revoked, edited, or even removed. It seems that the quality control process for Windows updates over the past few years has become increasingly poor.

Application on Microsoft Store

Microsoft Store applications, though focused on development, are only shortened versions of programs that are already running on Windows. Many users have never even downloaded an application from this Windows Store.



Privacy

Another major problem that Windows 10 faced right from its launch was privacy, as this update constantly collects data remotely. In recent years, Microsoft has been more transparent, but after installing Windows 10, it still enabled many user tracking settings by default.

Perhaps Microsoft needs to focus on fixing problems with existing features to provide a better user experience.
