

# Simple and effective way to treat moldy walls

Humid weather can easily lead to mold appearing on walls and indoors. Mold is not only unsightly but can be harmful to health, so it is important to detect and remove it early.



## Use alcohol

Alcohol is a special ingredient that has a disinfecting effect, so you can use alcohol to disinfect any necessary items. When the wall is moldy in an area that is not too large, you can use alcohol to clean bacteria and remove mold.

## Use vinegar and baking soda

Mix baking soda and vinegar well, then use a broom to apply the mixture to the wall where there is mold. After 10 - 15 minutes and then rinse with clean water, the mold on the wall will be removed.

## Use fresh lemon

Lemon contains a lot of citric acid, so it is often used as a cleaning agent. Therefore, you can also use lemon to remove mold on the wall. You just need to rub lemon or lemon juice on the mold stains, then use a brush to scrub, then wipe away with a clean cloth.

## Use soap

Dilute soap with water in a 1:3 ratio, then use a brush soaked in the solution to scrub the moldy wall. Then, rinse with water.

This method is not very effective in cleaning mold on walls, so it can only be used when the mold condition is not severe.

## How to prevent mold on walls

To prevent mold on the wall, you can immediately apply the following simple methods:

1. Use paints that are resistant to mold to avoid water leaks that cause mold on the wall.
2. Use a disinfectant spray bottle and clean the wall to effectively prevent mold.
3. If possible, you can use dehumidifying devices such as turning on air conditioners, dehumidifiers. to limit mold on the walls.
4. To avoid mold, you should regularly clean your walls.
