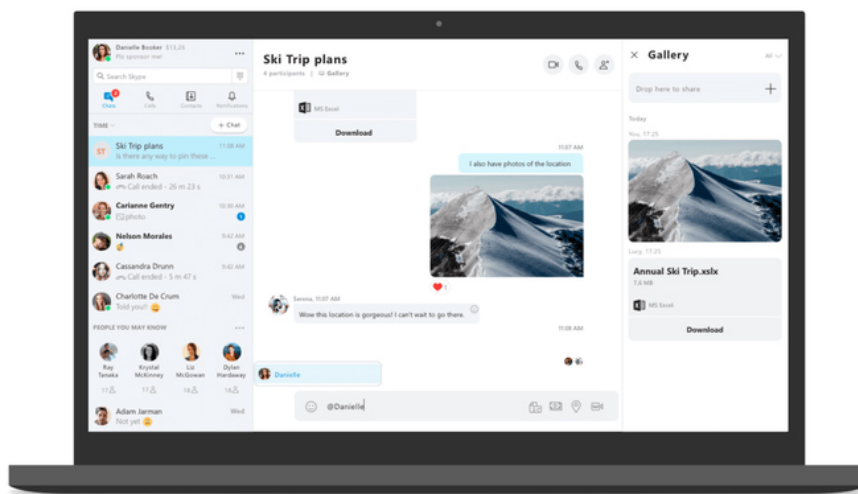


Skype 8.0 was criticized by users, Microsoft decided to keep Skype Classic
