## **Communicate from anywhere**

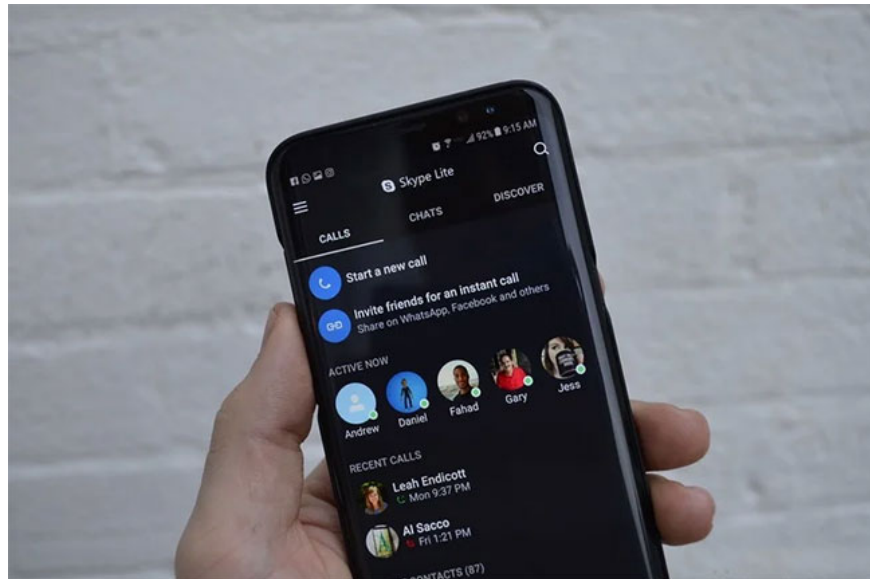


Skype allows text, voice and video communication from all favorite platforms
