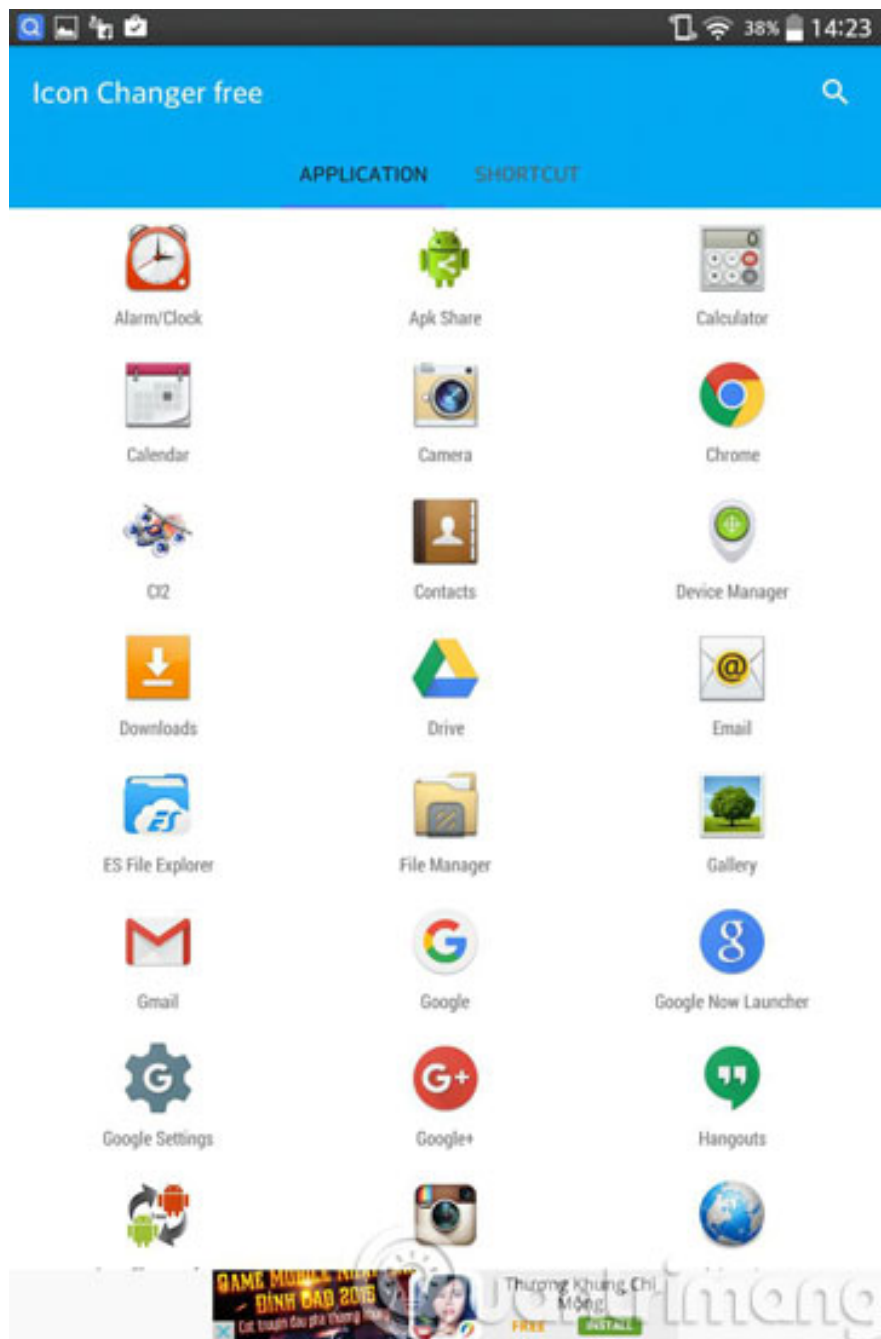


# Small tips to help you rename and Android application icons

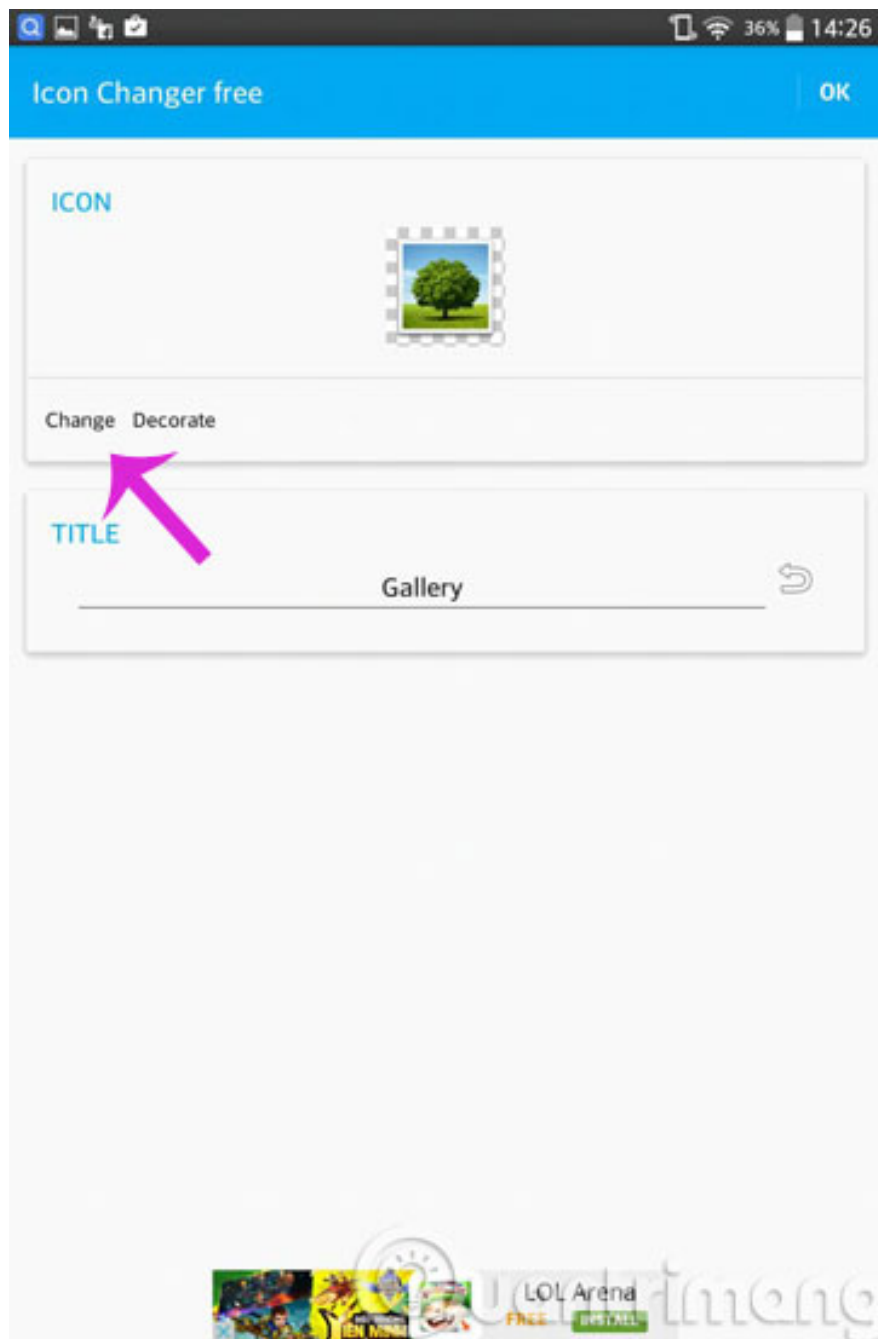

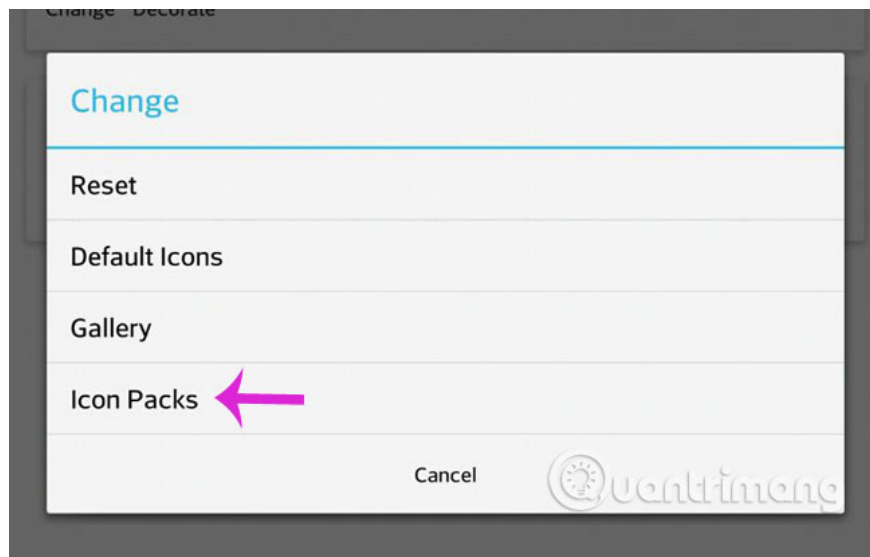
**Step 1** : Open the Icon Changer application on your Android device and select the application you want to change the name and icon ( *here, we choose Photos app* )



**Step 2 :** In the new interface, click **Change** to change the icon for the application



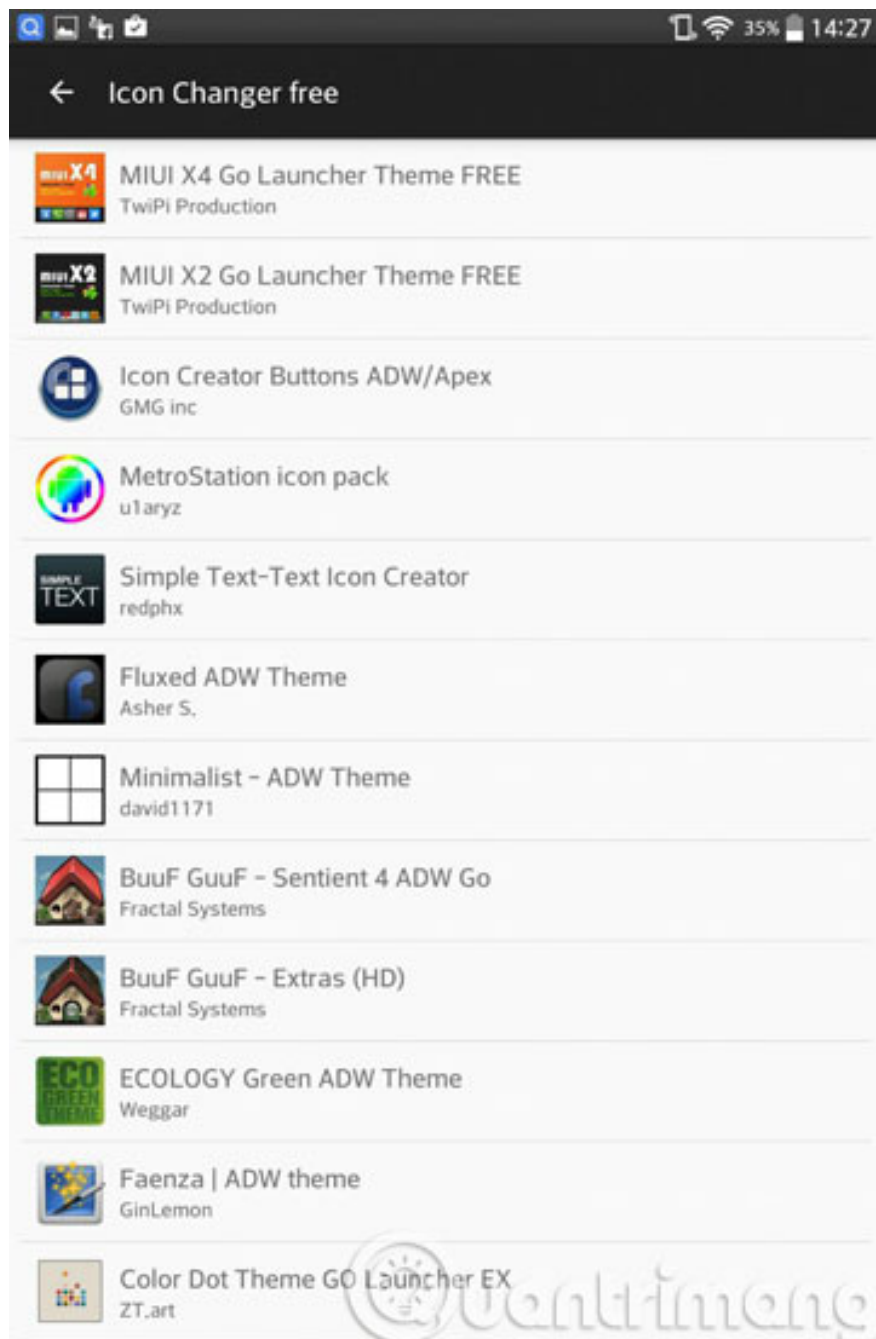
**Step 3 :** When the **Change** dialog box appears, you will have the following options



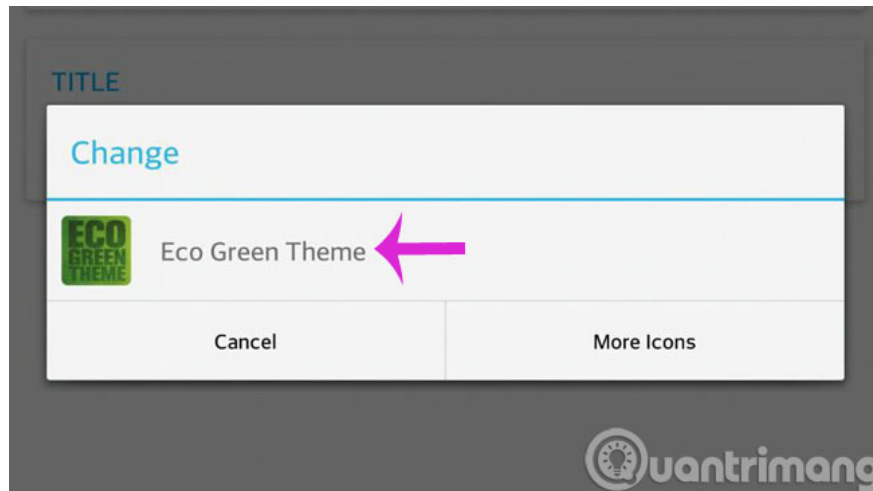
1. **Reset** : Restore the old icon
2. **Defaults icon** : Default icon
3. **Gallery** : Use images in devices as icons
4. **Icon Packs** : Application icon packs

Here, we choose Icon Packs

**Step 4** : Download an icon pack you like about the device

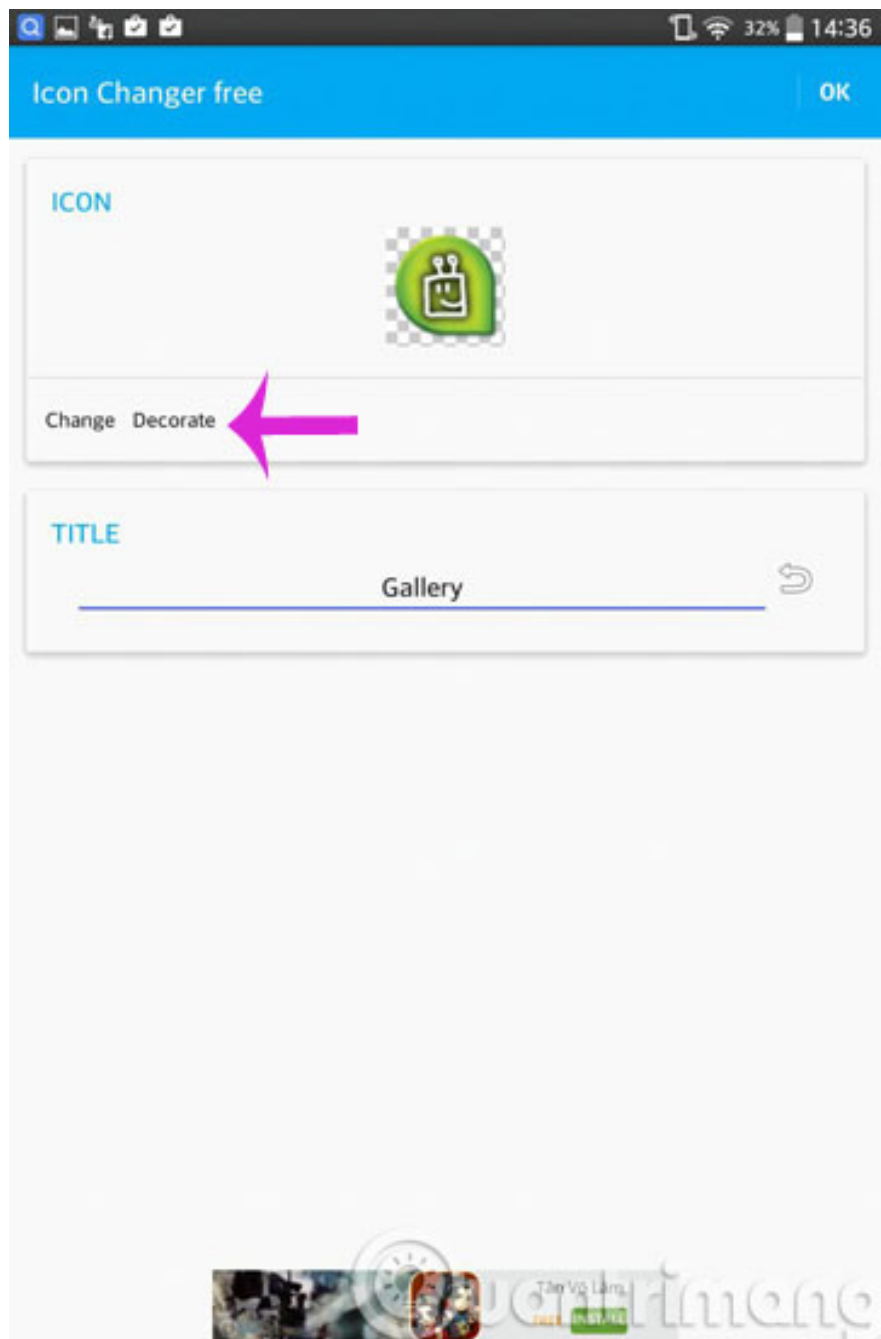


**Step 5 :** After downloading, click on it

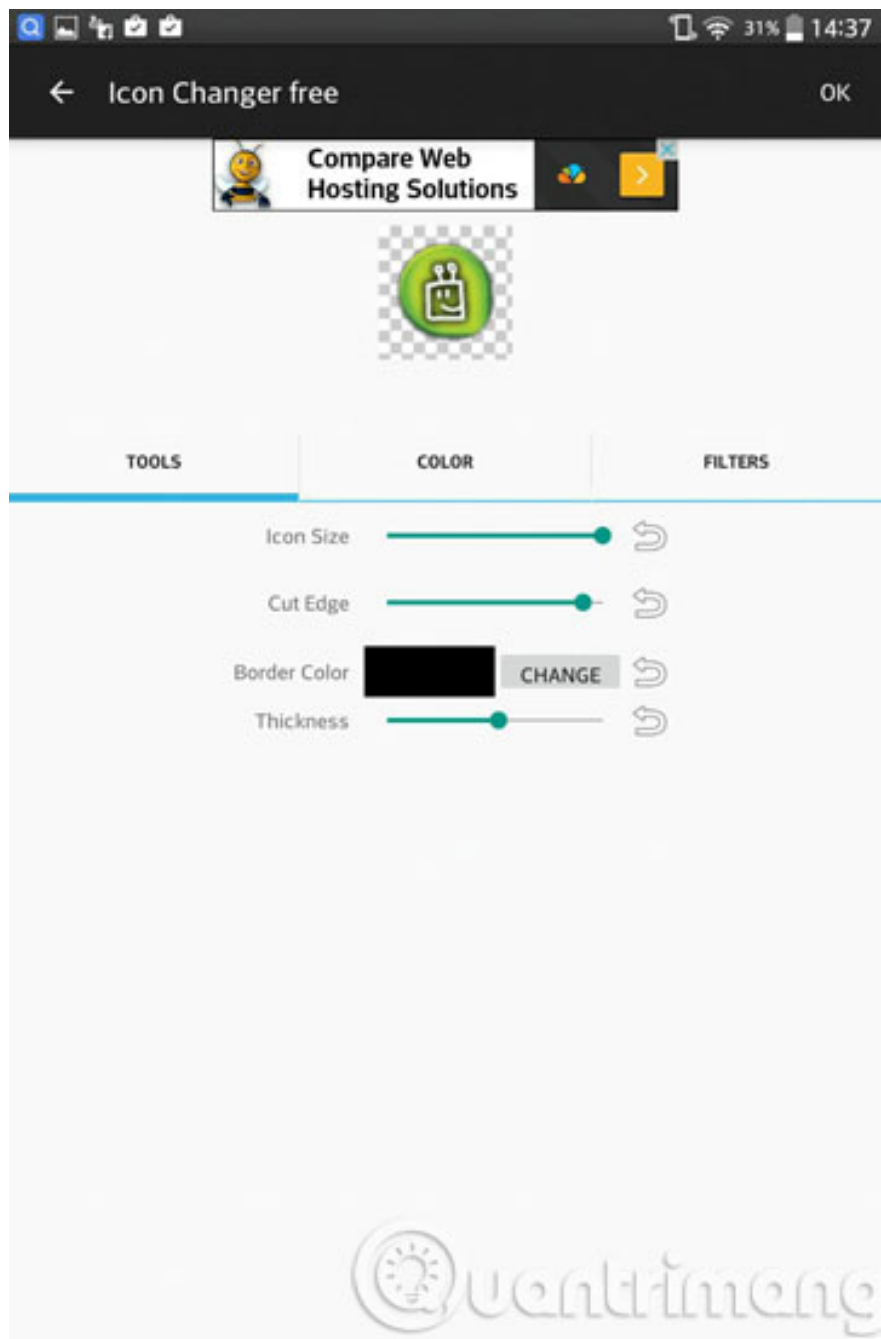


**Step 6** : Choose an icon you like in this icon pack

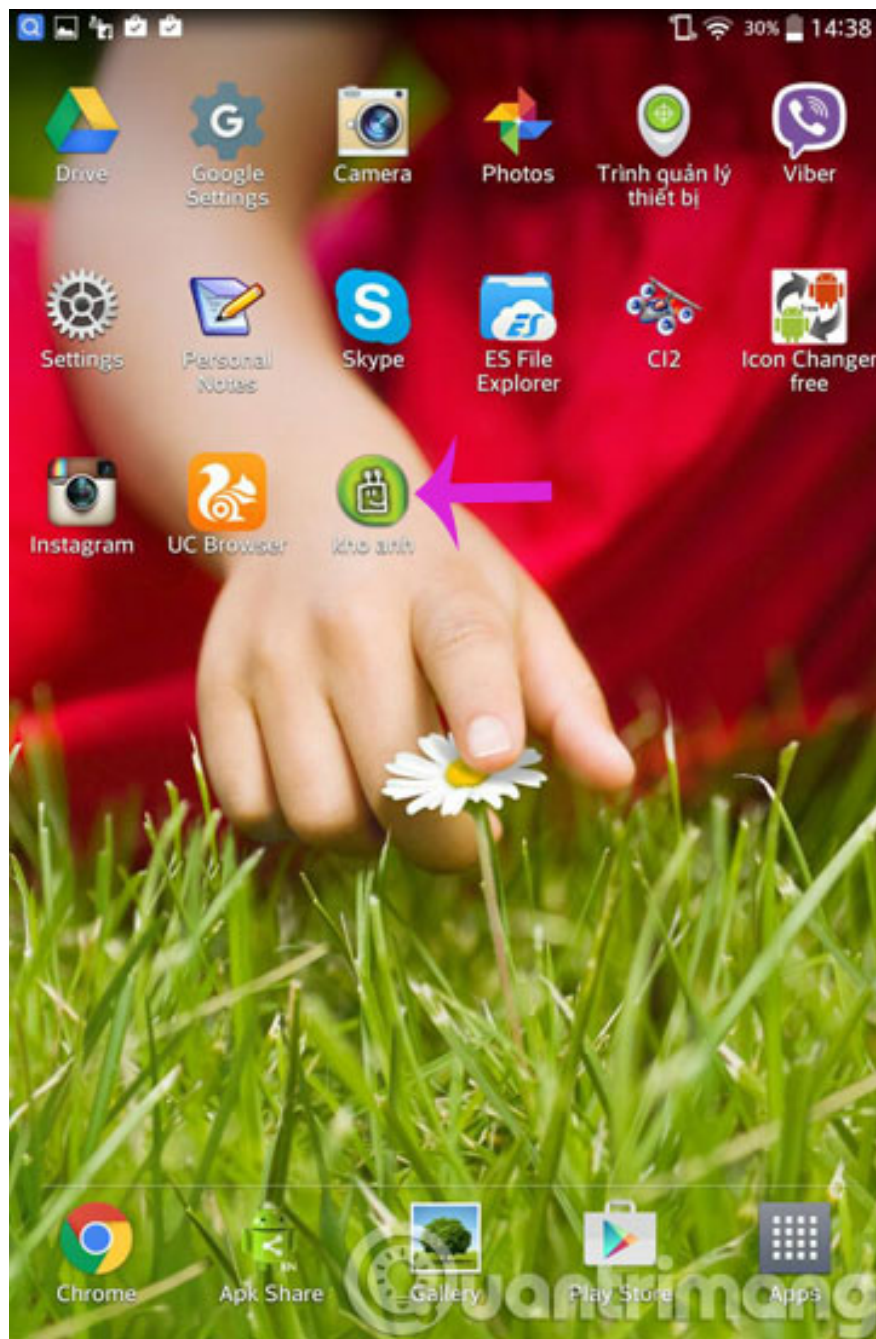




**Step 8** : Here, you can change the color, size . for the icon. Then, click **OK** to save the changes.



**Step 9** : Click **OK** to finish and you will see the results below
