However, the World Cup or Euro in recent years is also the season to change owners of smartphones and tablets. Browse through forums and classifieds in Vietnam during the World Cup season, you can easily find boxes selling products in the form: *'iPhone 5 needs to go with WC (World Cup)'* or *'Under WC, need to fly fast LG G2 in the day'*.

The products that have to change hands during the World Cup season by its owners for many different reasons no longer want to keep them with mainly smartphones (*smartphones*), tablets (*tablets*) and cameras., laptop., in which the phone is still the most popular device.

The common point of the sale of this product is that sellers often offer relatively low prices compared to the common ground and tend to soon sell machines to collect cash. Capturing this mentality, many people have waited until the World Cup to buy cheap old products, even boxed machines for a few days but owners need to sell at a bargain price.

Mr. S., born in 1991, is one of them. He was satisfied with the 16 GB Nexus 4 version, which was bought by *' a World Cup player '* (according to him) for 3 million dong. *' The market price of used Nexus 4 version 16 GB is about 3.5 - 3.7 million but I only pay 3 million and can buy it because the owner needs to sell urgently '*.

According to Mr. S., he bought an iPhone 5, a cheap LG G Pro in the same way for his friends, before finding himself a Nexus 4. " *This season, there are many merchants. fake family who lost the World Cup to sell cheap machines, actually deliberately sucked people to buy cheap tickets but just need to be a little observant, will find out right away where is the user machine sold, where are the merchants* ' .

He said, users can verify by checking the transaction history of the seller or when coming to see, also need to check carefully the machine details and it is best to buy a machine with warranty.

Not just classifieds, some phone shops are also the destination of new host searches, so reluctantly. Mr. Tri - the owner of a phone shop in Xa Dan, Hanoi, said that the number of people selling and buying (mainly selling) old machines increased sharply during the World Cup days. ' *There are people who have bought a machine at the store for a few days and brought it back, suffered a loss of two million dong,* ' he said.

' *The store side often buys very selective machines, because the old machine is a picky product line. Therefore, the store only chose to buy hot, easy-to-sell models and a long warranty to ensure easier resale .* '

New World Cup has not yet passed half the way and certainly, there will be smartphones, tablets, laptops continue to find new owners reluctantly as above. The advice for users is to be a football lover in a genuine way, to avoid unwanted host searches from devices that are considered to be unrelated.
